

College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong Traveling Fellowship

I. Objective:

The objective of the traveling fellowship is to sponsor young fellows of our college with advanced overseas training for their continuous professional development, which may include attachment, workshops, short training courses and study tours. However, course of study leading to a degree/diploma/certificate will not be supported.

II. Nature of award:

The tenure of the award is for duration of minimum 4 weeks. The award will be a fixed amount with the maximum of \$50,000 for the year 2006-2007

III. Country of study / training:

There is no restriction on the country of study / training. The applicant is responsible for securing the overseas training post with appropriate visa and insurance.

IV. Mode of Operation:

1. There will not be any fixed program organized by the College. Each applicant is free to propose his or her traveling and attachment program. However, the amount of sponsorship will be fixed.
2. All the co-ordination work will be handled by the College Secretariat and the Traveling Fellowship Secretary. The Council will select the successful applicant. The council may invite the short-listed candidates for an interview.
3. The result of the selection will be announced in September 2006.
4. Each successful applicant will have a period of maximum 18 months for making arrangement of the attachment. Such long period will enable him /her to apply the leave of absence from their employers and to find suitable locum dentists for their practices. The money will be issued by the Honorary Treasurer at the commencement of the attachment. The selected fellow should inform the Traveling Fellowship Secretary one month before the commencement of the training in order to prepare the cheque.
5. At the completion of the traveling fellowship, a certificate of attachment needs to be signed by the appropriate authority and a

report of attachment has to be submitted to the College Council through the Traveling Fellowship Secretary. The documents have to be submitted within three months after the completion of attachment.

6. The successful candidate will attend the conferment ceremony / annual dinner and receive a diploma from the President.
7. The Fellowship cannot be held in conjunction with any other award, grant, fellowship or scholarship.
8. The successful applicants will be required to sign a deed of agreement setting out acknowledgements with the College in respect of the Award.
