I am very thankful to all Councillors for their enormous efforts over these eleven months to maintain our quality and standards in education, examination, networking, and Members' and Fellows' welfare. In particular, I would like to thank Vice-Presidents Dr HO Fu Tak and Dr FANG Tak Sang Daniel for their leadership in training, examination, and continuing medical education (CME); Honorary Secretary and Chair of House and Scholarship Committees, Dr YU Jerome, who is instrumental in ensuring the stability of our Secretariat manpower; Honorary Treasurer Dr SHE Tsang Tsang who is making sure the College's financial health; Membership Committee Chair Dr SO Cheuk Hang for all Members and Fellows admission; Scientific Meetings Committee Chairman Dr HO King Lun for the very successful Scientific Meeting "Promoting Oral Health and Healthy Aging: Strategies for Geriatric Patients" held in July 2024; Information Technology Committee Chairman Prof LAM Yu Hang, and Publication Committee Chairman Dr LAW Yee Hung for their leading roles.

Recently, we welcomed the new Dental Young Fellows Chapter 2024-2025. We thank Dr WONG Wing Sze and her team for maintaining the well-being of all our newer Members and Fellows and, from time to time, those who are more mature.

The work of the Education and Examinations Committee has been particularly demanding, and Dr HO Fu Tak, under the auspices of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM), spearheaded the competency-based medical (dental) education initiatives and supervised retreats and workshops for such development in various Specialty Boards, and the development of Learning OnLine (LOL) educator courses, to name a few. A similar situation is for the CME subcommittee (CME SC), under the shadow of the Dentists Registration (Amendment) Ordinance 2024 after July, with the view of the mandatory Continuing Professional Development (CPD) for all practicing dentists from 2026 onwards, Dr FANG Tak Sang Daniel and his team are actively preparing to embrace the new changes at the horizon including our attentions, when necessary, in the differences between CME and CPD. The latest initiative from the CME SC is the CME/CPD Calendar on the CDSHK website. Please do utilise this convenient tool.

Under the background of the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the People's Republic of China, we are witnessing more bidirectional engagements between HKAM, CDSHK, and the Mainland Agencies and our colleagues. Despite dental special registration pending consolidation at the Mainland Stomatological scene, the Central Government clearly indicated and advocated our involvement and contributions to the Greater Bay Area (GBA) for Healthy China and internationalisation, perhaps with the aid of artificial intelligence. I am sure the current and next Councils will put our acts together, under the lead of HKAM and the Government of the HKSAR, to ensure the success of this National strategic plan.

On a sad note, may I invite all of us to pay our respects to our Honorary Fellows, Prof QIU Weiliu and Dr TSANG Yick Sang Jeffrey MBE, who unfortunately passed away in May and September 2024, respectively. Both gentlemen contributed significantly to dentistry in PR China, Hong Kong, and globally.

On a happy note, we look forward to conferring 30 Members and 18 Fellows in our coming Conferment ceremony on 17 November 2024. May I invite our Members and Fellows to participate and congratulate them on their remarkable achievements!

I would like to express my sincere gratitude to all the members of the College Council for their invaluable contributions to the growth of the College during my first year as President. As we face challenges ahead, the College is a collective responsibility that all Fellows share. Our common goal is to uphold the highest standards of specialised oral healthcare for our patients in Hong Kong and the GBA. It is imperative that the College also focuses on enhancing general oral healthcare services and providing advanced training programs with international recognition. Our Council will address these critical matters and more in the coming year.

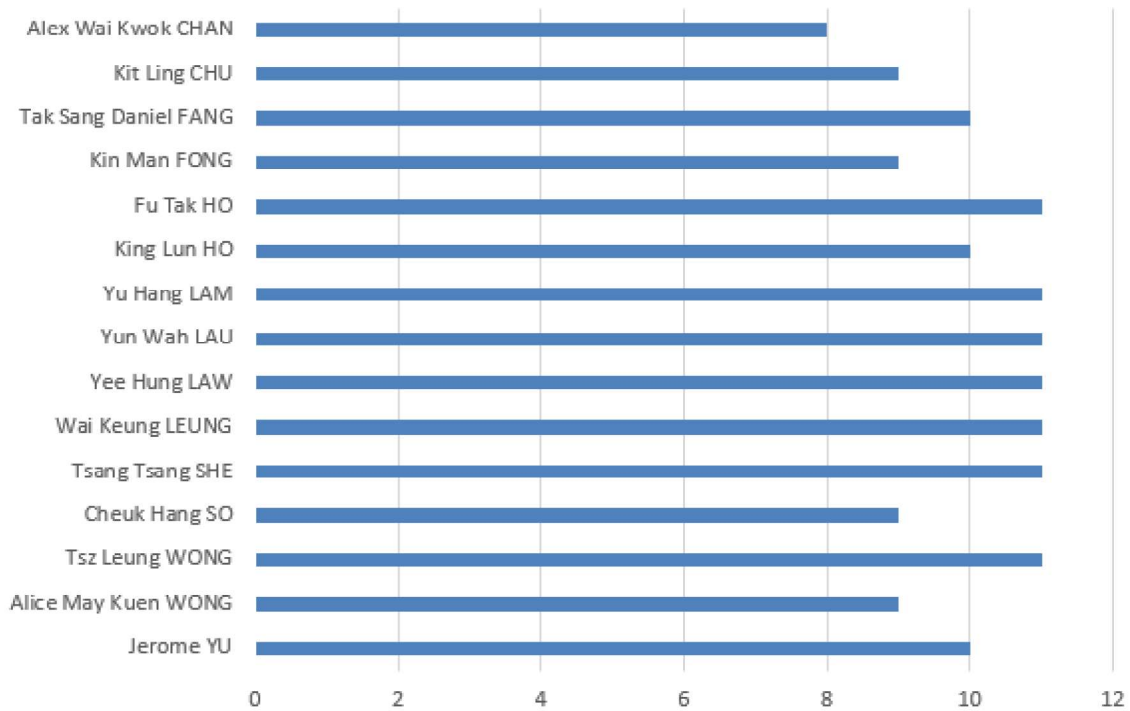

The Committee held six meetings between November 2023 and October 2024. The main issues handled include:

## Framework of Faculty Development

- Direction and Approach: Align with the Academy's vision and contemporary medical education principles in dental specialist education.
- Specialty Pathways: Encourage specialties to review pathways, integrating a competency-based approach and essential professional core competencies.
- College Retreat: Organise retreats to enhance understanding of Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME) in dental specialist curricula, training, and assessment.
- Participation Encouragement: Promote attendance at CBME seminars and medical education conferences organized by the Academy.
- Online Learning: Encourage fellows to enrol in the Online Educator Course and Basic Medical Education Course to enhance their training skills.
- Future Training Initiatives: Plan courses on Basic Assessment Skills for Examiners, Workplace-Based Assessment, Feedback, and BMEC.
- E-Portfolios: Work with specialties on developing e-portfolios and formative assessments.

## Training

- Application Vetting: Review applications of Basic and Higher Trainees.
- Progress Documentation: Maintain records of trainee status and progress.
- Leave Applications: Vet and follow up on trainee leave applications.
- MGD Training Arrangements: Organize Membership in General Dentistry (MGD) Training Program and Specialty Pathways (new MGD program diet initiated).
- MGD Mentorship: Nominate mentors for the MGD Training Program and Specialty Pathways.

## **Examination**

- Examination Arrangements: Organise Intermediate and Exit Fellowship Examinations. (6 Intermediate Exams and 5 Exit Exams)
- Examiner Nomination: Nominate examiners for Intermediate and Exit Fellowship Examinations.
- Results Vetting: Review results of the Intermediate and Exit Fellowship Examinations.

## **Miscellaneous**

- Examination Guidelines: Form a working group to review examination organisation procedures; criteria for observer and examiner selection have been reviewed and approved. The timeline for arrangements was established by the E&EC committee. Future tasks include reviewing the roles and selection of External Examiners and Chief Examiners, as well as setting examination standards.
- E-Applications: Work with the IT committee to develop e-applications for trainees and examinations.
- MGD Accreditation Resolution: Address issues related to the holding of MGD following Fellow accreditation.
- CME Recommendations: Consider recommendations from the CME Subcommittee.
- Examination Appeals Management: Oversee examination appeal cases.
- CSR/CSQ Assessment: Finalize criteria for assessing CSR/CSQ for specialties in the Academy and manage accreditation of applicants' specialist registration.

### **Examination Overview:**

Five candidates attended the Intermediate Examination, and three attended the Exit Examination, which took place on 23 and 24 January 2024, respectively; all candidates successfully passed. The next Exit Examinations are scheduled for 24 February 2025, and 22 January 2026, while the next Intermediate Examination is set for 21 January 2026. Professor Noriaki Yoshida from Nagasaki University, Japan, served as the external examiner for the 2024 exams and will continue this role in 2025.

### **Current Trainees:**

The Faculty of Dentistry, HKU is hosting eight Basic Trainees. For Higher Training, two trainees are at the Yau Ma Tei Jockey Club Dental Clinic, Department of Health, one trainee is at the Harbour Building Orthodontic Clinic, Department of Health, ten trainees are at the Faculty of Dentistry, HKU.

### **Examination Preparation Panel:**

The Examination Preparation Committee members are actively involved in setting questions for the Intermediate and Exit examinations, updating examination formats, templates for training logbooks and case histories, and score marking rubrics.

### **Task Force on Competency-based Curriculum of Orthodontic Specialty Training**

After the CDSHK retreat on competency-based medical education for dental specialist training, the Specialty Board decided to form a task force, with its first meeting scheduled for the fourth quarter of 2024. It may spend 6 months to 1 year reviewing the competency-based curricula of the UK and other countries, and subsequently write up our core competencies and learning outcomes. The next step will be to formulate competency-based and workplace-based assessments, which may require additional time to discuss, test, and implement. We will also involve our specialty trainers and trainees at various stages of the discussion.

### **Advancing Dental Education**

This year, our Specialty Board members and trainers participated in two distinct educational courses: 1) Basic Medical Education course, and 2) Learning Online Educator Course. Applying the concept learned, the HKU training center launched its first eHKAM LMS course of CDSHK on 1 September, 2024, incorporating the 'Flipped Classroom' teaching model to enhance learning effectiveness.

Currently, we have eleven Basic Trainees and six Higher Trainees in the Specialist training pathway. Six Basic Trainees are eligible to sit for the Intermediate Examination, and three Higher Trainees are eligible to sit for the Exit Examination in November.

At present, there are three Specialty training centres. The training centre in the Faculty of Dentistry, The University of Hong Kong provides both Basic and Higher training, of which, Professor POW Ho Nang Edmond is the Training Supervisor. The two training centres under the Department of Health, Western Dental Clinic and Sheung Kwai Chung Prosthodontic Clinic, offer Higher training. Dr WONG Tsz Leung is the Training Supervisor.

We are very privileged to have twelve Trainers providing clinical supervision and advice to our Trainees. ## Continuing Medical Education Sub-committee

2024 is the second year of the 3-year CME/CPD cycle. The role of the CME Sub-committee is to vet and accredit worthy CME/CPD events to keep Fellows, Members and Trainees informed and up-to-date, and to maintain a high standard of professional practice in line with HKAM current CME/CPD guidelines.

The background of the organiser, qualification of the speaker, content of the CME/CPD activity, as well as the degree of commercial influence are scrutinised. Between 1 January 2024 and 31 August 2024, the CME Subcommittee has vetted and accredited a total of 511 scientific meetings, conferences and educational courses held locally and overseas (492 approved / 19 rejected).

In order to facilitate our Fellows, Members and Trainees to participate in the accredited events, we have launched the CME calendar, easily accessible from the CDSHK website (cdshk.org) with hyperlink available from the College homepage. The CME/CPD events are chronologically arranged and colour coded (purple for Dentally-related, yellow for non-Dentally related, green for overseas).

### **CDSHK Scientific Meeting 2024 Promoting Oral Health and Healthy Aging: Strategies for Geriatric Patients 27 - 28 July 2024**

Given a rapidly aging population across the globe, the escalating medical burden already caught the attention of both healthcare policy makers and frontline healthcare providers. The theme of this year's Annual Scientific Meeting was "Promoting Oral Health and Healthy Aging: Strategies for Geriatric Patients". The 2-day scientific symposium and hands-on activities served as an invaluable platform for sharing of knowledge and insights, contemporary research and evidence, and clinical experiences and strategies.

In response to the challenges arising from the aging population and increasing prevalence of chronic diseases, the Health Bureau of the HKSAR Government released the Primary Healthcare Blueprint in December 2022. We were honored to have Dr PANG Fei Chau, the Commissioner for Primary Healthcare, kick off the meeting and deliver the Keynote Lecture titled "Development of Preventive Care in Medical and Dental Care in Hong Kong". Dr PANG shared their works on strategies and delivery of primary healthcare. One of the key objectives is to strengthen the services and better utilise the resources by tipping the balance from treatments more towards prevention. Current public dental services as well as more future collaboration between the medical and dental field were also highlighted. Afterall, we are optimistic that "*the mouth is put back to one's body*".

In our daily clinical practices, geriatric patients coming in could bring along with them a huge variety of oral health problems. We were delighted to have distinguished local speakers from different specialties coming together to share with us the tactics to overcome those challenging cases.

Following Dr PANG's lecture, Professor Colman McGRATH, Clinical Professor in Dental Public Health, continued the discussion on the impact to oral health care. With special care dentistry, and particularly aged care, being one of his expert clinical and research areas, Prof McGRATH compiled and elucidated further the latest global data and models of this agenda and shared his insights on successful and healthy aging in the context of oral health.

Dr LAW Yee Hung, Specialist in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, generously showcased her colorful atlas of oral pathologies in geriatric patients that she encountered in her office. Dr LAW's presentation not only gave us an eye-opening overview of both common and uncommon conditions,

but also enhanced our ability to recognise and promptly intervene or refer some of the not-so-benign conditions.

The second day of the Event started again with a topic that is more preventive-oriented. Dr WONG Sing Yan Philip gave us a lecture on the metabolic disease model and their relationship with oral health and health span. He walked us through the novel concept of epigenetics, mechanistic relationships between various metabolic problems, *e.g.*, insulin resistance, and oral conditions, non-pharmaceutical lifestyle management, *etc.* Through the discussion, the audience had a chance to reflect on and reexamine their health strategies, both as a health-conscious individual and a healthcare professional.

Apart from the hard and soft tissue pathologies which were covered on the first day of the Event, tooth loss and the subsequent decline in masticatory capability would undoubtedly be another impactful matter to the elderly, in a detrimental way. Dental caries and periodontal disease have long been the leading causes of tooth losses. Professor LO Chin Man Edward, Specialist in Community Dentistry, in his lecture gave us a review on the characteristics and associated factors of root caries. The utilisation of minimally invasive procedures, such as atraumatic restorative treatment (ART) and topical fluoride application, in particular silver diamine fluoride (SDF) solution, were discussed. Professor LEE Angeline Hui Cheng, Specialist in Endodontics, was also invited to walk us through some of the “geriatric-specific” endodontic challenges in which routine treatment approaches cannot always be readily applied. Her vibrant recapitulation and roleplay on how to tackle these unfortunate events added a lot of fun to our meeting.

When it comes to periodontal disease, tooth loss may perhaps be only the beginning of the nightmare. Classic presentation of pathological tooth migration and secondary occlusal trauma, so on and so forth, further complicate the situation. It was our pleasure to have Professor FOK Melissa Rachel and Dr WAN Kong Yuk Annie, our Specialists from Periodontology and Prosthodontics, to exchange their ideas and clinical experiences on rehabilitating elderly patients. Professor FOK first discussed periodontal considerations in planning for tooth replacement in geriatric patients. She also gave us an in-depth appraisal on the potential of utilising the shortened dental arch concept in older adults. When Dr WAN was on stage, she beautifully presented the use of removable prostheses as an economical yet highly effective solution in rehabilitating old-aged patients through management of cases commonly found in geriatric patients, *e.g.*, profound tooth drifting, reduced occlusal vertical dimension, severe tooth wear, *etc.* Sometimes, collaboration with orthodontic colleagues also plays a crucial role in managing the sequelae of tooth losses, especially in cases when teeth migration becomes unsightly. Dr YEUNG Yat Cheong, Specialist in Orthodontics, joined in to explore the orthodontic considerations and assess the relevant factors to consider when executing their biomechanical plans. The realignment of the deranged dentition greatly facilitates the rehabilitation and improves the long-term maintainability of the dentition. The Annual Scientific Meeting was concluded by a presentation of a clinical case which is jointly managed by colleagues from periodontics, orthodontics and prosthodontics. Thanks to the presentation by Dr CHAN Yat Him (Periodontology), Dr SUM Fung Hou Mineaki Howard (Orthodontics) and Dr CHU Ryan Julian Dick Hei (Prosthodontics), we can appreciate how our colleagues from different specialties can put together our expertise into clinical execution and work for the best interests of our patients.

Apart from the informative lectures, two hands-on workshops were held.

Professor LIM Tong Wah and Dr WAN Kong Yuk Annie jointly organised the workshop “Restorative Solution for Open Gingival Embrasures” to address the aesthetic concern of black triangles. Direct restorative technique using composite resins is considered a straightforward and cost-effective solution to camouflage the interdental spaces. The injection molding technique was demonstrated to achieve aesthetically pleasing result by the use of anatomical clear mylar matrices.

Dr HO King Lun held the workshop “Alveolar Ridge Preservation: Current Evidence and Techniques”, which covered techniques for ARP in terms of biomaterial handling and wound management with different suturing techniques. The clinical approach opened another treatment option and alternative to routine guided bone regeneration aiming at minimising the invasiveness of implant therapy, in particular with additional advantages for geriatric patients.

Finally, we would like to express my sincere gratitude to all the Speakers, Moderators, Members of the Scientific Meeting Committee, College Secretariat and HKAM Technical Support Team for their collaborative effort in preparing the Event. Support and invaluable feedback from the attendees are greatly appreciated. we would also like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the generous and unceasing support from our sponsors – Haleon, Peak Dental Solutions HK Ltd./Modern Dental Laboratory CO. Ltd., Solventum Hong Kong Limited, Nobel Biocare Asia Ltd., Medical Protection Society, Colgate Palmolive HK Ltd., and KT Medical Supply Limited. Together, we have made the Annual Scientific Meeting 2024 a huge success.

Regarding the evaluation, more than 95% of the responses had rated our academic forum above satisfactory and 100% of the responses had rated the two workshops to be appropriate to excellent. Some qualitative comments were received and discussed during the council meeting.

Another collaborative event with Medical Protection Society was successfully held on 15 October 2024. We were very fortunate to have Dr James Foster from MPS to present us with a unique topic “Avoiding Burnout and its Dentolegal Consequences Overview.” The event was delivered online and had more than 180 attendees.

The council has pleasure in presenting its report together with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2024.

**PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES**

The principal activities of the college are promoting for the public benefit the advancement of knowledge in the field of dental surgery and its associated subjects and promoting training and research in dental surgery.

**FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

The financial performance of the college for the year ended 31 March 2024 and the financial position of the college at that date are set out in the financial statements on pages 6 to 15.

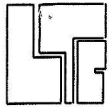

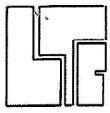
**OTHER INFORMATION**

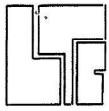

## NOTES ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (“the college”) was incorporated in Hong Kong on 23 February 1993 as a company limited by guarantee. Every member of the college undertakes to contribute, if required, an amount not exceeding HK\$100 to the assets of the college in the event of its being wound up.

The address of the registered office of the college is Room 902, HKAM Jockey Club Building, 99 Wong Chuk Hang Road, Aberdeen, Hong Kong.

The college is engaged in promoting for the public benefit the advancement of knowledge in the field of dental surgery and its associated subjects and promoting training and research in dental surgery.

The financial statements are presented in Hong Kong dollars which is the same as the functional currency of the college.

### 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the periods presented, unless otherwise stated.

a) Basis of preparation:

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities (“HKFRS for Private Entities”) issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (“HKICPA”) and the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. These financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention.

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with HKFRS for Private Entities requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenditure. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances, the results of which form the basis of making the judgments about carrying values of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised if the revision affects only that period, or in the period of the revision and future periods if the revision affects both current and future periods.

### 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

#### b) Property, plant and equipment:

Property, plant and equipment, other than construction in progress are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment losses. The cost of an asset comprises its purchase price and any directly attributable costs of bringing the asset to its working condition and location for its intended use. Expenditure incurred after the property, plant and equipment have been put into operation, such as repairs and maintenance, is normally charged to the statement of comprehensive income in the period in which it is incurred. In situations where it can be clearly demonstrated that the expenditure has resulted in an increase in the future economic benefits expected to be obtained from the use of the property, plant and equipment, the expenditure is capitalised as an additional cost of that asset.

Depreciation on property, plant and equipment is calculated by the straight-line method to allocate cost to their residual value over their estimated useful lives as follows:

College gowns	20% per annum
Leasehold improvement	20% per annum
Furniture and fixtures	20% per annum
Office equipment	20% per annum

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at the end of each reporting period. An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognized upon disposal or when no future economic benefits are expected to arise from the continued use of the asset. The gain or loss arising on derecognition of the asset (calculated as the difference between the net sale proceeds and the carrying amount of the asset) is included in the statement of comprehensive income in the year in which the item is derecognized).

#### c) Inventories:

Inventories are stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost is calculated by using the weighted average method. Net realizable value is determined by management based on prevailing market conditions.

#### d) Impairment:

At the end of each reporting period, the college reviews internal and external sources of information to determine whether the carrying amounts of its tangible assets have suffered an impairment loss or impairment loss previously recognised no longer exists or may be reduced. If any such indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset is estimated, based on the higher on its net selling price and value in use.

If the recoverable amount of an asset is estimated to be less than its carrying amount, the carrying amount of the asset is reduced to its recoverable amount. Impairment losses are recognised as an expenditure immediately.

#### 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

d) Impairment: (cont'd)

A reversal of impairment losses is limited to the carrying amount of the asset that would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognised in prior years. Reversal of impairment losses is recognised as income immediately.

Impairment loss on financial assets which is carried at amortised cost is measured as the difference between the asset's carrying amount the present value of estimated future cash flows discounted at the financial asset's original effective interest rate.

e) Revenue recognition:

Income from subscription and entrance fees is recognised on an accruals basis.

Income from meeting, course and examination is recognised upon completion of services provided.

Interest income is recognised as it accrues using effective interest method.

f) Related parties:

a) A person, or a close member of that person's family, is related to the college if that person:

- i) has control or joint control over the college;
- ii) has significant influence over the college; or
- iii) is a member of the key management personnel of the college or the college's parent.

b) An entity is related to the college if any of the following conditions applies:

- i) The entity and the college are members of the same group.
- ii) One entity is an associate or joint venture of the other entity (or an associate or joint venture of a member of a group of which the other entity is a member).
- iii) Both entities are joint ventures of the same third party.
- iv) One entity is a joint venture of a third entity and the other entity is an associate of the third entity.
- v) The entity is a post-employment benefit plan for the benefit of employees of either the college or an entity related to the college.

f) Related parties: (cont'd)

b) An entity is related to the college if any of the following conditions applies: (cont'd)

- vi) The entity is controlled or jointly controlled by a person identified in (a).
- vii) A person identified in (a)(i) has significant influence over the entity or is a member of the key management personnel of the entity (or of a parent of the entity).
- viii) The entity, or any member of a group of which it is a part, provides key management personnel services to the group or to the group's parent.

Close members of the family of a person are those family members who may be expected to influence, or be influenced by, that person in their dealings with the entity.

g) Cash and cash equivalents:

For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand and demand deposits, and short term highly liquid investments which are readily convertible into known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value, and have a short maturity of generally within three months when acquired, less bank overdrafts which are repayable on demand and form an integral part of the college's cash management.

h) Retirement benefit costs:

The college joins a defined contribution retirement scheme under the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance (the "MPF Scheme") for those employees of the college.

The college's contributions to the MPF Scheme are made based on a percentage of the eligible employees' relevant income as defined in the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance. These contributions are expensed as incurred. The assets of the scheme are held separately from those of the college in independently administered funds.

i) Government grants:

Government grants are recognised in the statement of financial position initially when there is reasonable assurance that they will be received and that the college will comply with the conditions attaching to them. Grants that compensate the college for expenses incurred are recognised as revenue in the statement of comprehensive income on a systematic basis in the same periods in which the expenses are incurred. Grants that compensate the college for the cost of an asset are deducted in arriving at the carrying amount of the asset and consequently are recognized in the statement of comprehensive income over the useful life of the asset.

## **INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE COLLEGE OF DENTAL SURGEONS OF HONG KONG**

### **OPINION**

We have audited the income and expenditure account set out on page 3 in respect of the Activity "Membership in General Dentistry ("MGD") Examinations 2021-2023" ("the Activity") held by The College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong ("CDSHK") ("the income and expenditure account"), which has been prepared in accordance with the Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("HKFRSs").

In our opinion, the income and expenditure account gives a true and fair view of the surplus for the period from 1 January 2021 to 31 August 2023 of the Activity in accordance with the HKFRSs.

### **BASIS FOR OPINION**

We conducted our audit in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing ("HKSA") issued by the HKICPA. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Income and Expenditure Account* section of our report. We are independent of CDSHK in accordance with the HKICPA's *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants* ("the Code"), and we have fulfilled other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

### **CDSHK'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT**

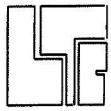
CDSHK as an administrator of the Activity is responsible for the preparation of the income and expenditure account of the MGD Examinations 2021-2023 that gives a true and fair view in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and the true and fair presentation of the income and expenditure account that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error; selecting and applying appropriate accounting policies; and making accounting estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

In preparing the income and expenditure account, the CDSHK is responsible for assessing the Activity's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless CDSHK either intends to liquidate the Activity or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

### **AUDITOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE AUDIT OF THE INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT**

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the income and expenditure account as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. This report is made solely to you, as a body, in accordance with our agreed terms of engagement, and for no other purpose. We do not assume responsibility towards or accept liability to any other person for the contents of this report.

## AUDITOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE AUDIT OF THE INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT (CONT'D)

Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with HKSA's will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these income and expenditure account.

As part of an audit in accordance with HKSA's, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the income and expenditure account, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Activity's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by CDSHK.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of CDSHK of the Activity's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the activity's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the income and expenditure account or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the activity to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the income and expenditure account, and whether the income and expenditure account represents the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
