Under the auspices of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM), Dr HO Fu Tak, the CDSHK Education Facilitator, spearheaded the competency-based medical (dental) education initiatives by organising various workshops, including Basic Assessment Skills for Examiners and Basic Medical Education Course for Dental, as well as leading the programme for mental well-being and support for the trainees.

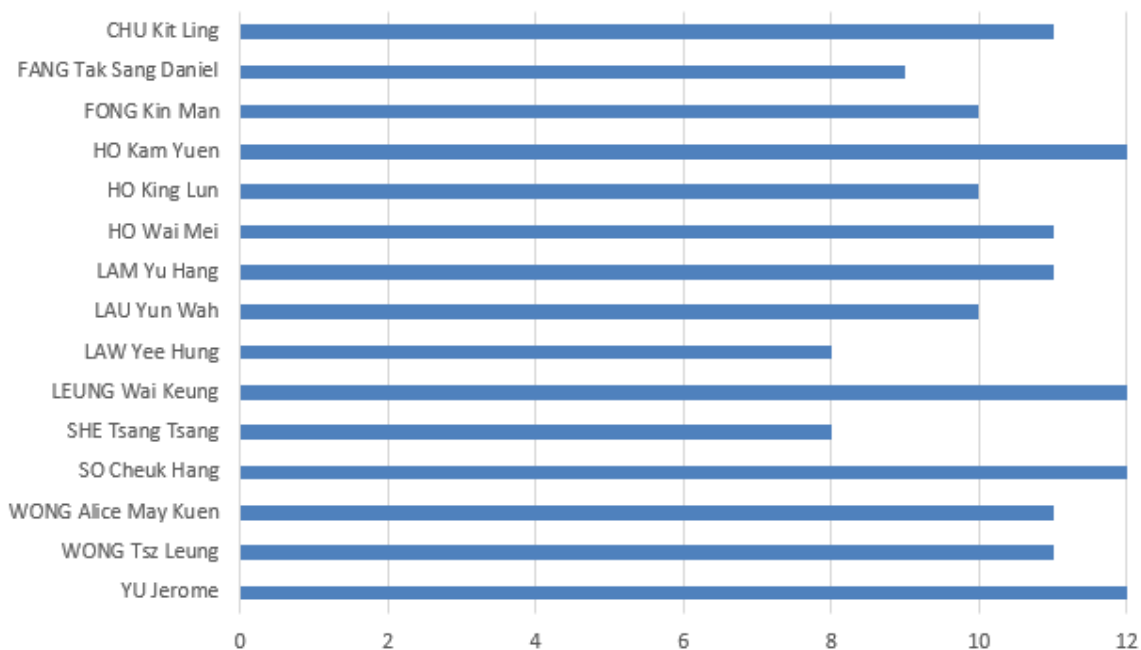

The Committee held six meetings between December 2024 and November 2025 since last Annual General Meeting. The main issues handled include:

Framework of Faculty Development

Direction and Approach: Aligning with the vision of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (Academy) and contemporary medical education principles in dental specialist education;

Specialty Pathways: Encouraging specialties to review pathways, integrating a competency-based approach and essential professional core competencies;

Participation Encouragement: Promoting attendance at Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME) seminars and medical education conferences organized by the Academy;

Promoting Courses organised by the Academy: Encouraging fellows with sponsor from College to enrol in the Learning Online Educator Course, Basic Medical Education Course organised by the Jockey Club Institute for Medical Education and Development (JCIMED) of the Academy to enhance their training skills;

Organising Courses for Faculty Development: Basic Medical Education Course (BMEC) for supervisors and trainers and Basic Assessment Skills for Examiners (BASE) Course customised for the CDSHK were successfully held in April and May 2025 respectively.

- Organising Specialty Training Pathways and Membership in General Dentistry (MGD) Training Programme;

Continuing the work of the then Working Group in drafting and publishing of the first version of the “CDSHK Guidelines for Examinations”; and

Developing electronic records in collaboration with the IT committee for applications and training records of trainees.

Key Activities and Updates

- Specialty Board Meetings
Regular meetings of the Specialty Board were convened at intervals of one to two months.
- Intermediate Examination Results
Two trainees successfully completed the Intermediate Examination in November 2024.
- Revision of Training Guidelines
The appendix pertaining to the Exit Examination for the Specialty of Endodontics has been formally amended. A comprehensive review and revision of the remaining sections of the training guidelines is currently in progress.
- Basic Trainee Development Program
A case presentation and discussion session for basic trainees was conducted on 29 March 2025, aimed at enhancing clinical reasoning and peer engagement.
- Endodontics Exit Examination Briefing
A dedicated meeting with Higher Trainees in Endodontics was held on 30 April 2025. The session focused on the updated appendix of the training guidelines and provided guidance on examination preparation.
- Intermediate and Exit Examination
A joint Restorative Intermediate Examination was organized in December 2025, followed by Exit Examination the week after.

- The written examination and the viva examination of the Intermediate Examination were conducted on 17 and 24 September 2024. Dr KO Hay Ching Brian was the Chief Examiner for the Intermediate Examination. A total of seven candidates sat for the examination. Dr CHOW Tsz Kwan Michael, Dr MAK Pui Ying, Dr NG Wing Yau, Dr HO Chui Yi, Dr CHEUNG Ming Yan and Dr LEUNG Tsun Sun passed the examination.
- The guidelines for accreditation and training in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery were revised and enforced on 9 December 2024. Trainees admitted on or after the date should comply with the new training requirement as stipulated in the guidelines. A briefing session was held on 14 April 2025 via Zoom. The new guidelines were explained, and a Q&A session was included at the end of the session.
- Exit Examination was held on 3 and 10 January 2024 for three candidates. Professor LEUNG Yiu Yan Mike was the Chief Examiner of the Examination. Dr PU Jingya and Dr TAM Yim Ha successfully passed the examination.
- The next Exit Examination will be scheduled on 2 and 9 January 2026. Professor LEUNG Yiu Yan Mike will be the Chief Examiner of the Examination.
- Up to September 2025, there are 26 registered trainees in specialty of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, consisting of 13 Basic Trainees and 13 Higher Trainees.

Examination Overview

On 24 February 2025, we conducted the Exit Examination, attended by six candidates, of whom three successfully passed. Subsequently, a resit Exit Examination was held on 3 September 2025, with two candidates participating; both successfully passed. Looking ahead, the next Intermediate Examination is scheduled on 21 January 2026, followed by the Exit Examination on 22-23 January 2026. We are honoured to have Professor Noriaki YOSHIDA from Nagasaki University, Japan, serve as the external examiner for these examinations.

Current Trainees

The Faculty of Dentistry at HKU currently hosts 7 basic trainees and 6 higher trainees. The Yau Ma Tei Jockey Club Dental Clinic hosts 2 higher trainees, while the Harbour Building Orthodontic Clinic hosts 1 higher trainee.

Competency-based Orthodontic Curriculum

Given the rapid advancements in orthodontics, updating the existing curriculum is now imperative. To date, the development of a new competency-based orthodontic curriculum is progressing well. Once completed, the document will be distributed to all stakeholders for opinions and revision, with the hope of securing council approval in 2026.

Faculty Training and Development

In alignment with the development initiatives of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM), members of the Specialty Board, trainers, examiners, and observers participated in various educational courses. These included the Basic Medical Education Course, Basic Assessment Skills for Examiners, and the Examiner Training Workshop. Such participation underscores our commitment to continuous professional development and excellence in orthodontic education.

Training Centres

There are three Specialty training centres. The training centre in the Faculty of Dentistry, the University of Hong Kong provides Basic and Higher training, of which, Professor POW Ho Nang Edmond is the Training Supervisor. The other two training centres under the Department of Health, Western Dental Clinic and Sheung Kwai Chung Prosthodontic Clinic, offer Higher training. Dr WONG Tsz Leung is the Training Supervisor.

Continuing Medical Education Sub-committee

2025 is the last year of the 3-year CME/CPD cycle. The role of the CME Sub-committee is to vet and accredit worthy CME/CPD events to keep Fellows, Members and Trainees informed and up-to-date, and to maintain a high standard of professional practice in line with HKAM current CME/CPD guidelines.

The background of the organiser, qualification of the speaker, content of the CME/CPD activity, as well as the degree of commercial influence are scrutinised. Between 1 January 2025 and 31 August 2025, the CME Subcommittee has vetted and accredited a total of 757 scientific meetings, conferences and educational courses held locally and overseas (692 approved / 65 rejected).

CDSHK SCIENTIFIC MEETING 2025 — Future of Dentistry 26-27 July 2025

The Annual Scientific Meeting was held on 26–27 July 2025 at the Academy of Medicine. Building upon the foundational success of the previous year’s focus on Geriatric Dentistry, this year’s event, themed “The Future of Dentistry,” served as a pivotal forum for professional advancement. The meeting facilitated two days of rigorous intellectual exchange, practical skill development, and strategic visioning, uniting esteemed local and international experts to chart the evolving trajectory of the dental profession.

The programme was structured around three transformative themes that are critical to the future of dental medicine: technological innovation, the evolution of specialist education, and the unique perspectives from our new generation of practitioners.

I. Keynote Addresses: Strategic Insights on Progress and Innovation

1. Transformative Technologies in Clinical Practice

This session illuminated the integration of advanced technology into modern practice. Professor Thomas CONNERT presented ground breaking advancements in AI and 3D imaging for minimally invasive endodontics, enhancing procedural precision. Dr LUI Chun Tat explored the revolutionary impact of AI and immersive simulation technologies on medical education, while also addressing pragmatic challenges such as implementation costs. Dr HO Cheuk Hin detailed sophisticated digital workflows, from AI-driven treatment planning to the fabrication of customized appliances, underscoring a commitment to precision and patient-centric care.

2. The Evolution of Specialist Training

A critical examination of modern educational methodologies was presented. Dr SO Hing Yu advocated for a shift from traditional behaviorist models towards dynamic, learner-centered principles to cultivate resilient and adaptable clinicians. Dr HO Fu Tak outlined the College’s proactive implementation of Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME), ensuring our curricula remain responsive to contemporary patient needs. A panel discussion featuring Dr CHENG Hung Wai Ronald, Dr LIEW Cho Hwei Julianna, and Dr WONG Tsz

Leung together with Dr SO Hing Yu and Dr HO Fu Tak fostered a robust dialogue on refining training pathways to balance development on curriculum with demands on trainers and the contemporary needs for dental specialist.

3. Young Fellows' Global Perspectives

This segment highlighted the invaluable contributions of the College's younger Fellows. Dr George WRIGHT provided essential guidance on dentolegal awareness and risk management for building a resilient practice. Dr LIU Hin Nam offered a comparative analysis of periodontal education in Hong Kong and London. Dr YUEN Ha Ching emphasized the critical importance of cultural adaptability and shared advanced techniques gleaned from an international fellowship. Dr FOK Tat Chuen and Dr HO Ka Leong presented on the modern management of advanced periodontitis, demonstrating the application of the updated AAP/EFP classification through complex clinical cases.

II. Hands-On Workshops: Advancing Clinical Excellence

Complementing the theoretical discussions, a series of practical workshops provided attendees with opportunities to elevate their clinical skills:

- **Crafting Superior Direct Composite Resin Veneers:** Led by Professor LIM Tong Wah and Dr LEE Tse Kwan, Louisa, this session focused on mastering the art and science of creating aesthetic, durable, and minimally invasive restorations.
- **Technical Tips and Tricks of Surgical Wound Closure:** Under the guidance of Dr SO Cheuk Hang, Dr LAW Yee Hung, and Dr HO King Lun, participants engaged in immersive training on basis on closure techniques and the exploration on more complex wound management for grafting and harvesting site.
- **Advanced Interdisciplinary Digital Strategies:** This debut workshop, co-led by Professor LAM Yu Hang and Dr LAU Yun Wah, provided hands-on experience in integrating digital technologies for orthodontic and prosthodontic treatments, including digital smile design and the fabrication of customized occlusal splints.

III. Gratitude and Forward Momentum

The success of the 2025 Scientific Meeting was a testament to the collective effort of the CDSHK Council, the Scientific Meeting Committee, and the dedicated Secretariat team. We also extended our profound gratitude to our sponsors, distinguished speakers, and all participants whose engagement and shared commitment to excellence were instrumental. The addition of new sponsors to this year's scientific meeting was a welcome development. Their partnership not only provided vital support but also served as endorsement to the meeting's esteemed position within our industry.

Participant feedback for the Scientific Meeting was positive, reflected in a 95% above satisfaction rate overall. The workshops were especially lauded, receiving consistent ratings from "very good" to "excellent." The constructive comments provided by attendees have yielded critical insights that will directly guide the future development and enhancement of our scientific programmes.

The vibrant exchanges and innovative ideas generated over these two days have provided significant momentum. As we look to the future, it is clear that the path forward is one of

collaboration, innovation, and unwavering dedication to advancing the standards of dental care for the benefit of our profession and the patients we serve.

Activities of DYFC in 2024-2025

“Workshop on Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Cap. 633) – points to note including legal requirements on small practice clinics” was held on 29 October 2024. Dr Andrew BUT and Dr Kathy CHAN, the Senior Dental Officers of Dental Regulatory and Law Enforcement, Department of Health introduced the requirements for Day Procedure Centre (DPC) and small practice clinics under Cap. 633 to our fellows and trainees as our second activity of DYFC. The workshop highlighted some important points in complying with requirements under Cap. 633, covering governance, staffing, facilities and equipment, service delivery, quality and safety of care, infection control, and other operational matters. Dr BUT and Dr CHAN provided lots of useful tips with examples illustrating the application of Cap. 633. The attendees enjoyed the workshop and actively participated in small group discussions by raising questions relevant to their current practice. The interactive section was useful particularly to those young fellows who plan to start a new practice in the future.

On 23 February 2025, “Workshop on Effective Communication Skills for Complaint Management” was held. Ms Scarlett TSOI, an expert in mediation and counselling enhanced our skills in handling complaints with real case scenario illustrations. Her lively presentation aroused the attendees’ interest. She also introduced the VAK (visual, auditory and kinaesthetic) learning model to analyse our own strengths and weaknesses, which was very useful when tackling conflicts. The participants were invited to have a role play to simulate real life situation when handling complaints. All the participants enjoyed so much especially when their role was “patients” to make a complaint face to face to their “dentist”.

On 3 August 2025, “Workshop on Cultivating Wellness: Mindfulness for Dental Professionals” was held. Over 30 participants joined this workshop. Dr LEUNG Chung Ming, registered Clinical Psychologist, and Ms KONG Po Ying Cathy, Applied Behaviour Analysis Therapist and Counsellor, gave lectures on Mindfulness and Applied Analysis Therapist. Dr LEUNG taught us to practise Mindfulness during our daily life. Ms Cathy KONG shared her experience in flower arrangement and taught us to apply mindfulness during flower jamming. By engaging in a mindfulness-based stress relieving activity, we learned to enhance self-awareness, overall mental well-being and overcome daily challenges in our dental profession.

Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Young Fellow Chapter (HKAM YFC)

Professor LAM Pui Ying Phoebe and Dr WONG Kaye Wing Sze, young fellows from Paediatric Dentistry and Community Dentistry respectively, have been selected as the 2025-26 YFC representatives from the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong. Professor LAM serves as the YFC vice-chairperson and is a representative on the HKAM Research Subcommittee, as well as eLearning and Technology Subcommittee. Dr WONG serves as the honorary treasurer and is a member of the HKAM Professionalism and Ethics Committee. Treasurer's Report (2024-2025)

For the financial year from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025, the College reported a deficit of HK\$213,406. As of 31 March 2025, the accumulated funds stood at HK\$7,010,529. Total income for the year was HK\$2,985,249, while total expenditure amounted to HK\$3,198,655.

The College's major sources of income remained consistent:

1. **Membership and Subscription Fees**
2. **Examinations & Programs** (Intermediate & Exit Examinations, CME, and MGD Program)
3. **Scientific Meeting**

Expenditure increased significantly compared to the previous financial year, primarily due to the following factors:

1. **Increased Staff Costs:** This reflects the full-year impact of previous recruitment and salary adjustments for the secretariat team. Total salaries, allowances, and Mandatory Provident Fund contributions exceeded HK\$2.06 million.
2. **Substantial Repairs and Maintenance:** Major upkeep projects were undertaken during the year, with related costs exceeding HK\$251,000.
3. **Resumption of Activities:** The full resumption of normal operations led to increased costs, including significant expenditures on functions and the Conferment Ceremony (over HK\$265,000), as well as travel expenses (over HK\$120,000).

Despite this year's deficit, the College's financial position remains solid. It is important to note that the previous year's surplus was significantly bolstered by a one-off gain from the Tri-Collegiate Scientific Conference. The College continues to review all expenditures carefully to ensure long-term financial sustainability.

On behalf of the College, I wish to express my sincere gratitude to our Senior Executive Officer, Ms Iris YEUNG, and our Executive Officers, Ms Jeanne CHAN, Mr Alaric CHEUNG, Ms Mousse HO, Ms Wing LEUNG, and Ms Serina SO, for their dedicated service and prudent financial management during this challenging year.

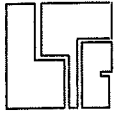

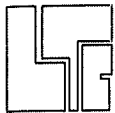
OTHER INFORMATION

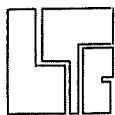


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

NOTES ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (“the college”) was incorporated in Hong Kong on 23 February 1993 as a company limited by guarantee. Every member of the college undertakes to contribute, if required, an amount not exceeding HK\$100 to the assets of the college in the event of its being wound up.

The address of the registered office of the college is Room 902, HKAM Jockey Club Building, 99 Wong Chuk Hang Road, Aberdeen, Hong Kong.

The college is engaged in promoting for the public benefit the advancement of knowledge in the field of dental surgery and its associated subjects and promoting training and research in dental surgery.

The financial statements are presented in Hong Kong dollars which is the same as the functional currency of the college.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the periods presented, unless otherwise stated.

a) Basis of preparation:

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities Accounting Standard as issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (“HKICPA”) and the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. These financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention.

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with HKFRS for Private Entities Accounting Standard requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenditure. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances, the results of which form the basis of making the judgments about carrying values of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised if the revision affects only that period, or in the period of the revision and future periods if the revision affects both current and future periods.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

b) Property, plant and equipment:

Property, plant and equipment, other than construction in progress are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment losses. The cost of an asset comprises its purchase price and any directly attributable costs of bringing the asset to its working condition and location for its intended use. Expenditure incurred after the property, plant and equipment have been put into operation, such as repairs and maintenance, is normally charged to the statement of comprehensive income in the period in which it is incurred. In situations where it can be clearly demonstrated that the expenditure has resulted in an increase in the future economic benefits expected to be obtained from the use of the property, plant and equipment, the expenditure is capitalised as an additional cost of that asset.

Depreciation on property, plant and equipment is calculated by the straight-line method to allocate cost to their residual value over their estimated useful lives as follows:

College gowns	20% per annum
Leasehold improvement	20% per annum
Furniture and fixtures	20% per annum
Office equipment	20% per annum

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at the end of each reporting period. An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognized upon disposal or when no future economic benefits are expected to arise from the continued use of the asset. The gain or loss arising on derecognition of the asset (calculated as the difference between the net sale proceeds and the carrying amount of the asset) is included in the statement of comprehensive income in the year in which the item is derecognized).

c) Inventories:

Inventories are stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost is calculated by using the weighted average method. Net realizable value is determined by management based on prevailing market conditions.

d) Impairment:

At the end of each reporting period, the college reviews internal and external sources of information to determine whether the carrying amounts of its tangible assets have suffered an impairment loss or impairment loss previously recognised no longer exists or may be reduced. If any such indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset is estimated, based on the higher of its net selling price and value in use.

If the recoverable amount of an asset is estimated to be less than its carrying amount, the carrying amount of the asset is reduced to its recoverable amount. Impairment losses are recognised as an expenditure immediately.

d) Impairment: (cont'd)

A reversal of impairment losses is limited to the carrying amount of the asset that would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognised in prior years. Reversal of impairment losses is recognised as income immediately.

Impairment loss on financial assets which is carried at amortised cost is measured as the difference between the asset's carrying amount the present value of estimated future cash flows discounted at the financial asset's original effective interest rate.

e) Revenue recognition:

Income from subscription and entrance fees is recognised on an accruals basis.

Income from meeting, course and examination is recognised upon completion of services provided.

Interest income is recognised as it accrues using effective interest method.

f) Related parties:

a) A person, or a close member of that person's family, is related to the college if that person:

- i) has control or joint control over the college;
- ii) has significant influence over the college; or
- iii) is a member of the key management personnel of the college or the college's parent.

b) An entity is related to the college if any of the following conditions applies:

- i) The entity and the college are members of the same group.
- ii) One entity is an associate or joint venture of the other entity (or an associate or joint venture of a member of a group of which the other entity is a member).
- iii) Both entities are joint ventures of the same third party.
- iv) One entity is a joint venture of a third entity and the other entity is an associate of the third entity.
- v) The entity is a post-employment benefit plan for the benefit of employees of either the college or an entity related to the college.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

f) Related parties: (cont'd)

b) An entity is related to the college if any of the following conditions applies: (cont'd)

- vi) The entity is controlled or jointly controlled by a person identified in (a).
- vii) A person identified in (a)(i) has significant influence over the entity or is a member of the key management personnel of the entity (or of a parent of the entity).
- viii) The entity, or any member of a group of which it is a part, provides key management personnel services to the group or to the group's parent.

Close members of the family of a person are those family members who may be expected to influence, or be influenced by, that person in their dealings with the entity.

g) Cash and cash equivalents:

For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand and demand deposits, and short term highly liquid investments which are readily convertible into known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value, and have a short maturity of generally within three months when acquired, less bank overdrafts which are repayable on demand and form an integral part of the college's cash management.

h) Retirement benefit costs:

The college joins a defined contribution retirement scheme under the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance (the "MPF Scheme") for those employees of the college.

The college's contributions to the MPF Scheme are made based on a percentage of the eligible employees' relevant income as defined in the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance. These contributions are expensed as incurred. The assets of the scheme are held separately from those of the college in independently administered funds.

i) Government grants:

Government grants are recognised in the statement of financial position initially when there is reasonable assurance that they will be received and that the college will comply with the conditions attaching to them. Grants that compensate the college for expenses incurred are recognised as revenue in the statement of comprehensive income on a systematic basis in the same periods in which the expenses are incurred. Grants that compensate the college for the cost of an asset are deducted in arriving at the carrying amount of the asset and consequently are recognized in the statement of comprehensive income over the useful life of the asset.
