## **Background**

- •The Hong Kong Government established the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Preparatory Committee 1990
- •The Committee completed draft legislation then submitted it to the Executive and Legislation Councils 1991
- •The Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Ordinance (cap. 419) was passed by the Legislation Council 1992



## Background (Cont'd)



- •The Academy of Medicine was officially inaugurated on 9 December 1993 with twelve Academy Colleges and two Faculties. Currently there are a total of fifteen Academy Colleges including the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong 1993
- •Construction of the Academy Building at Wong Chuk Hang started and an occupation permit was obtained. 1998

- •to promote training and research in Dental Surgery
