In July 2009, HKDA and CDSHK came to an agreement for HKDA to be the administrator of the Membership in General Dentistry (MGD) training program 2009-2011. The program is supported by various specialist societies which are accredited CPD providers of the Dental Council of Hong Kong (DCHK).

The training program is mainly designed to prepare the MGD trainees for the MGD Part I and Part II examinations. It is a competence-based program according to the guidelines of accreditation and training in MGD. For further details, please refer to CDSHK's website (www.cdshk.org).

The training program is module-based, consisting of CGD (Committee of General Dentistry) accredited lectures and workshops on clinical practice and essentials of dental practice on General Dentistry. There are some supporting programs to guide trainees in examination preparation and they can be useful to interested practitioners.

The modules are useful to colleagues who aspire to keep themselves abreast of the contemporary practice of General Dentistry and those who may wish to enroll as trainees in the next diet of examination. The credit points carried in completing the program will be counted as part of the requirements of the MGD training and examination. Dr Liu graduated with the Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) from the University of Hong Kong (HKU) in 1988. He also obtained the Postgraduate Diploma in Dental Surgery (PDipDS) from HKU and the Diploma in General Dental Practice (DGDP) from the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 1996. He acquired the Membership in General Dental Surgery (MGDS) from the Royal College of Surgeons (RCS) of Edinburgh in 1997. He was further awarded the Fellowship of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (FHKAM) in Dental Surgery and the Fellowship of the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (FCDSHK) in the specialty of Family Dentistry in 2003.

Apart from practising in the private sector for more than 20 years, Dr Liu has been working as a part-time lecturer of the Faculty of Dentistry of HKU since 1990. He held the position of Examiner of MGDS and MGD examinations. He is a member of the Specialty Board of Family Dentistry, and the Committee of General Dentistry, CDSHK. He is now Chairman of the Practice Support Committee of Hong Kong Dental Association and Vice President of the Hong Kong Society of Family Dentistry.
