President's Message



Dear Fellows & Members,

It is an honour to be able to serve as President in the 22nd year of the College. Since the founding of our College in 1993, through all selfless efforts of our senior colleagues, we have taken root in the postgraduate specialist training and flourished in a fertile soil of fraternity. There are at present eight specialty boards in our College, namely Community Dentistry, Endodontics, Family Dentistry, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Orthodontics, Paediatric Dentistry, Periodontology and Prosthodontics. For our colleagues in general dental practice, the College has established the Committee of General Dentistry.



Fellowship and Membership embrace more than qualifications for self-actualization or achievements of peer recognition. It is the fraternity that we all treasured. Our specialties might be different, our roots are the same.

At present, there are two undividable parts of postgraduate specialist training. The first part is the six years to hurdle the prescribed training pathways. The second part is the lifetime commitment to active learning, unlearning and relearning to maintain our professional knowledge, skills and more importantly – creditability to the patients whom we serve. The same principle applies to our Membership in General Dentistry (MGD) members.



President's Message

By and large, our medical colleagues in the other 14 sister colleges are "privileged" to be able to undertake on-the-job post-registration trainings. This is merely another way of paying for their training in kind. They have to provide extra clinical services, endure unsocial on-call duties, bear long working hours, sleepless nights etc. on top of their hard works to meet training demands.

Dental specialist trainings are seemingly different. Besides toil, tears and sweat, the road along the first six years of postgraduate specialist training needs to be paved with something that glitters. University-based postgraduate programmes are not subsidized by public funds unlike undergraduate studies. Outside the Faculty, "through-train" (both Basic and Higher training) on-the-job training posts are only found in the specialties of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Paediatric Dentistry, Community Dentistry and Family Dentistry. Self-financing education means excessive tuition fees for our aspiring young generations. How many of our young talents are barred from entering into specialist training pathways because of financial reasons, we do not know. More opportunities should be made available on the basis of merits, rather than merits and mammon.

More on-the-job training posts might be an answer. Collaboration is the key. Clinical services, albeit under supervision, can be provided akin to the "medical" model that has stood the test of time. There can be more integration and cross-overs in the university-based and other institution-based training programmes. This is actually less remote than it sounds. It is indeed happening in many specialties at present. Trainees can undergo training in the Basic part of his or her training pathway in one centre and proceed to the Higher part in another.

Apart from the maintenance of standards of the training programmes, the College will continue to advocate for more opportunities in postgraduate dental training and life-long professional development. I am grateful to all our Past Presidents, notably my predecessor, Prof. Edward Lo, in having laid down such a fine and solid foundation. With the collective wisdom from our fellow Council Members, Chairmen and members of the Special Boards and Chairmen and members of various committees, I am certain that our College will graciously take on the challenges ahead in a concerted effort.

Joint Collegiate Scientific Meeting 2014

The inaugural Joint Collegiate Scientific Meeting (JCSM) of the three dental colleges, College of Dental Surgeon of Hong Kong (CDSHK), College of Dental Surgeons, Singapore (CDSS) and Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons (RACDS) was held on 7th – 8th December 2014 at the HKAM Jockey Club Building. Around 340 attendees registered for this 2-day meeting. We invited two keynote speakers and other speakers coming from within and without the Asian Pacific region. The two internationally acclaimed keynotes speakers were Professor Ken Hargreaves from the United States and Dr Paul Sambrook from Australia. The other speakers were all renowned experts in their respective fields.

Professor Ken Hargreaves is currently the Professor and Chair of Endodontics and Professor of Pharmacology and Physiology, University of Texas Health Science Center, San Antonio, USA. He gave 3 lectures, namely “Regenerative Endodontics”, “Successful Management of Acute Dental Pain” and “Issues in Managing the Persistent Endodontic Infection” on the first day of meeting. The information was current and up-to-date and the attendees all found these lectures very interesting and informative.

Dr Paul Sambrook is the Head of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the School of Dentistry, University of Adelaide, Australia. He discussed the issues regarding “Neuropathic Pain and Analgesics” on the first day of the meeting. On the second day, he presented 2 lectures: “The Management of Odontogenic Infections” and “Common Medical Conditions and Oral Surgery”, which were very useful and practical to specialists as well as general dentists.

In addition, 2 speakers from Singapore were invited to share their expert knowledge in their fields.

Dr Rashid Tahir, a paedodontist in private practice, shared with us the “Minimum Intervention in Paediatric Dentistry – The Way Forward in Managing Caries for Our Children”. **Dr Teoh Khim Hean**, Senior Consultant & Department Director, Restorative Dentistry, National Dental Centre of Singapore (NDCS), gave an excellent presentation on “Maxillofacial Prosthetic Rehabilitation of the Head and Neck Patients: NDCS Experience”.

Last but not least, we were fortunate to have eminent academics and clinicians from Hong Kong to lecture at the meeting. From the Faculty of Dentistry, **Professor Esmonde Corbet**, Clinical Professor in Periodontology, Faculty of Dentistry, HKU, **Professor Gary SP Cheung**, Clinical

Professor in Endodontics, Faculty of Dentistry, HKU, **Dr Edmond HN Pow**, Clinical Associate Professor in Oral Rehabilitation, Faculty of Dentistry, HKU and **Dr Zhang Cheng-fei**, Associate Professor in Endodontics, Faculty of Dentistry, HKU were invited. From the private sector, **Dr Lim K Cheung**, Specialist in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in private practice as well as Honorary Clinical Professor of the Faculty of Dentistry, HKU was invited. All the speakers shared their knowledge in their fields selflessly and we all learnt a lot from them in this meeting.

An informal meeting was held with the RACDS and CDSS on 7 December. The current presidents of the three Colleges and some council members attended. It was initially agreed that the JCSM would be held in rotation by the three Colleges every two years. It was anticipated that CDSS would host the next Meeting in Singapore.

CDSHK Scholarship

The College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong Scholarship (“Scholarship”) has been set up to support Fellows admitted in or after the year 2010 and higher trainees in our specialist training pathways to receive overseas training. Preference will be given to young Fellows, i.e. those who are admitted within the previous 5 years.

The maximum amount of the Scholarship will be HK\$50,000 for the year 2015. The training programme will be self-arranged for duration of not more than 8 weeks and needs approval by the College. The Scholarship cannot be held in conjunction with any other award, grant or sponsorship that will give financial support for the same training.

Successful applicants will be required to participate in some College activities in the subsequent year as, for example, writing reflections about their training to be published in the College Publication, representing the College in some promotion functions, etc., as invited by the College Council.
