# Medical Education Conference 2017

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Medical Education Conference organized by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine. The conference was held on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2017 at the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building. The theme of the conference this year is “Modern Trends in Medical Education”. This conference drew attention of medical educators to some important aspects including professionalism, e-learning, workplace assessment, how to give effective feedback and simulation as a training tool. There were about 10 fellows and trainees from the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong participated in the conference.

The conference gave a lot of emphasis on the importance of professionalism and a number of experienced medical educators from Canada and Australia shared the knowledge and experience. Key speakers included Dr. Kevin IMRIE, Immediate Past President of The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, Dr. Viren NAIK, Director of Assessment of The Royal College of Physician and Surgeons of Canada and Laureate Prof. Nick TALLEY, Vice-Chancellor (Global Research) University of Newcastle, Australia. Apart from identifying different aspects of professionalism, they shared their experience on how to incorporate professionalism in their medical schools and how to access professionalism in a clinical setting. Moreover, there was a symposium for local medical educators to discuss on the teaching of professionalism in Hong Kong. Professionalism is of prime importance for good doctors and dentists and it is to be cultivated from the very beginning of the medical curriculum. It would also be effectively learned by active participation in the social welfare. Regular discussion on medical incidence would also be useful.

Moreover, modern medical teaching methods which included E-learning, simulation, workplace assessment, and feedback giving had been well discussed and gave a lot of inspirations to the participants. The speakers invited us to continue reflecting and enhancing our medical or dental education.

**IMPORTANT**

### Postage Due

Recently, the College Secretariat had been informed by the Post Office on a number of occasions that postage due was incurred by incoming mails and the Post Office requested the Secretariat to collect them as well as settling the outstanding postage.

The College Council had resolved the matter with the following principles/guidelines:-

1. Commencing 1 October 2016, CDSHK will NOT respond to the Post Office on request of such.
2. It is the responsibility of the sender to pay the postage and they should bear the consequence of inadequate postage.
3. For important mails, it is advised that they should be delivered by registered mail, courier service or in person.

## CME News Update

### *Reminder for Shortage of CME requirement*

It is the College's practice that Fellows/Members who are found to be in shortage of CME requirements will be reminded by email in September of the third year of the 3-year cycle so that they can make efforts for remedial actions. It should be emphasized that it is the obligation of the Fellows/Members to monitor their own CME status.

### *Chairing in Formal College Approved Activity (FCAA)*

In Item 8.2 of the College's Principles and Guidelines on CME and CPD 2017 – 2019, it states that chairing in a FCAA may be awarded 1 point per hour with an additional 1 point per morning, afternoon or evening session. The CME subcommittee has clarified the definition of a "session" and the limits of Co-chairman as follows:

- A session should last for a minimum of 45 minutes.
- The maximum number of Co-Chairmen in any FCAA is 2.
- However, to qualify for the additional one point, a minimum of 1.5 hours of chairing/co-chairing is required.

Therefore, any Chairman chairing a meeting which lasts for only one hour will not be awarded the additional point while chairing a two-hour meeting will be accredited with  $(2+1)=3$  CME/CPD points.
