President's Message

Dear Fellows and Members,

At the time of writing this message, Hong Kong has been facing a public health crisis of combating the new coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak originated from Wuhan of China. The battle may last for months. Being healthcare professionals, we should take vigilant measures in infection control for protection among us and prevention of cross infection. We should take part in curbing the spread of the epidemic in the community. I do hope you all stay healthy, calm and sober to face such an insurmountable threat to Hong Kong after SARS in 2003.



I am much honored and privileged to have been elected as the President of the College for the next 12 months. The present well-established activities and momentum of the College have been the result of incessant efforts and selfless contributions of past Presidents and Council members since 1993, to them the present Council being indebted to. It is sad to have learnt that Professor Stephen Hon Yin WEI, our inaugural president from 1993 to 1995, passed away in January 2020. Professor Wei had served in the College Council as a Council member till 1999 and in various positions such as an examiner and a specialty board member in Paediatric Dentistry till 2013. His dedication and contribution to the growth of the College was much remembered and commended. As he is now resting peacefully in the arms of God, we would like to express our deepest condolences to his family. I would like to give particular thanks to our immediate past President, Dr Edmond Ho Nang POW, who led us through a fruitful year of 2019.

The election of Councilors in November 2019 witnessed a high degree of participation. There had been a total of 200 ballot papers and eleven candidates for six posts. This signified increased awareness for better representation in the Council. The Council welcomes Dr Stanley Man Lung LAI and Dr Tsang Tsang SHE as new members. Dr Ricky Wing Kit WONG and Dr Raymond Yun Lok MAK left the Council after serving for 12 and 3 years, respectively. I must thank them for their contributions to the College. While Hong Kong had experienced unprecedented political turmoil, protests, divisions and violence, the College also faced an unusual litigation case

brought by a Fellow. The trial eventually ended in December 2019 and we are waiting for the Court Judgment.

Furthermore, the College confronts a number of challenges ahead. Firstly, because of the uncertainty in organizing Conjoint / Intermediate Examinations with the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (RCS Ed), the specialty boards of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and Periodontology are planning to conduct their own Intermediate Examinations in the near future. Secondly, there is a marked decrease in the number of candidates sitting for the Membership in General Dentistry (MGD) examination. It seems that many young aspiring dentists are more interested in taking overseas membership examinations. Thirdly, the establishment of a post-graduate training centre outside the Prince Philip Dental Hospital by the Faculty of Dentistry, HKU, may also affect the present training scenario and may have impacts on our trainees.

No matter what happens, the College would stay focus on our main goals – organizing and overseeing dental specialist training pathways, provision and ensuring continuous professional development, and catering the professional development needs of general dentists through MGD program. I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to all the specialty boards' chairmen and members and also the Committee in General Dentistry to make such goals and missions fulfilled. The work led by Ms Charlotte Chan, which has efficiently supported College activities is highly appreciated. However, Ms Lilian Cheung, who has served our College for over ten years, left the Secretariat in February 2020. We thank her for her contribution to the College, especially in the CME/CPD matters, and wish her all the best in her future endeavors.

Finally, let me end with a quote by Helen Keller: "Alone we can do so little; together we can do so much." Solidarity among us is the pre-requisite for us to overcome difficulties in order to strive forward and scale new heights for the College. Therefore, I would like to plead for your engagement, valuable comments and support. Hope that you all have a happy Chinese New Year and wish everyone a prosperous 2020.

53rd Singapore-Malaysia Congress of Medicine

53rd Singapore-Malaysia Congress of Medicine (SMCM)

Representing CDSHK, I joined the Hong Kong Delegation to participate in the above event on 18 January 2020. AMM-AMS-HKAM Tripartite Congress of Medicine has been held in every three years starting from 2010. However, the 4th Tripartite Congress cum 53rd SMCM, which was originally scheduled to be held in Hong Kong in 2019, had to be cancelled due to the persisting social unrest and the latter was thus held in Singapore.

The Hong Kong Delegation was led by Prof Gilberto Leung and Dr Chow Yu Fat of HKAM and consisted of Presidents of 8 Colleges (Fig 1). We all participated in the Joint Council Meeting of the three Academies of Medicine, the symposium featured “Opioids in Pain Management”, Induction Comitia in which the Presidents of Hong Kong Colleges were conferred Fellows of AMS, and Congress Dinner. I had friendly communications during the Congress Dinner with Prof Emeritus Dato’ Dr Lian Chin Boon, President of the College of Dental Specialists, Academy of Medicine of Malaysia (AMM) and Dr Andrew Ow, President of College of Dental Surgeons, Academy of Medicine of Singapore (AMS) (Fig 2).

Overall, the trip did strengthen solidarity among the three Academies of Medicine and paved the way for more collaboration in the future.

Specialty Education and Training Development Fund

The aim of the Specialty Education and Training Development Fund (SETDF) is to encourage Specialty Boards and the Committee in General Dentistry (CGD) to organize or conduct education and training activities for trainees, fellows, members, and/or trainers.

The specialty boards give positive feedback and view that the fund provides an opportunity to nurture trainer-trainee relationship which is essential for building a stronger team of trainers as well as encouraging trainees along the road to becoming a specialist.

Thus, the Council resolved to commence a fourth cycle of the fund, starting from 1 April 2020 till 31 March 2022. To utilize the special fund, each specialty board can submit relevant proposal(s) and budget(s), through Education & Examinations Committee, to the Council for approval of the corresponding activities.

News on Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

預防肺炎及 健康建議 呼吸道傳染病



- 經常保持雙手清潔
- 洗手時應以視液和清水清潔雙手，**搓手最少20秒**
- 當雙手沒有明顯污垢時，可用含70至80%酒精搓手液潔手
- 如廁後先蓋廁板再沖廁
- 徹底清潔雙手
- 吐痰應用紙巾包好再丟
- 妥善保養排水渠管定期注水入U型隔氣
- 每星期把半公升水倒入所有排水口
- 打噴嚏或咳嗽時應用紙巾掩蓋口鼻，正確棄置已染污的紙巾，然後徹底清潔雙手
- 如沒有紙巾，可用上衣或上袖掩蓋
- 當出現發燒或呼吸道感染病徵，應戴上外科口罩及盡早向醫生求診
- 有顏色/褶紋向下的面向外，有金屬條的一邊向上
- 橡筋繞在耳朵上
- 拉開口罩，完全覆蓋口、鼻和下巴
- 把金屬條沿鼻樑兩側按緊，緊貼面部

Prevention of Pneumonia and Respiratory Tract Infection



- Perform hand hygiene frequently
- Wash hands with liquid soap and water, and rub for at least 20 seconds
- When hands are not visibly soiled, hand hygiene with 70 to 80% alcohol-based handrub is effective
- After using toilet, put the lid down before flushing
- Wash hands thoroughly
- Spit into tissue and dispose of it properly
- Maintain drainage pipes properly and add water to the U-traps regularly
- Pour half a litre of water into each drain outlet every week
- Cover your mouth and nose with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing, dispose of soiled tissues into a lidded rubbish bin, then wash hands thoroughly
- If tissue is not available, may cough into clothes or upper sleeves
- When having a fever or respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask and seek medical advice promptly
- The coloured side/side with folds facing downwards should face outwards with the metallic strip uppermost
- Position the elastic bands around both ears
- Extend the surgical mask to fully cover mouth, nose and chin
- Mould the metallic strip over nose bridge, to fit snugly over the face

Condolences

A tribute to the memory of Professor Stephen Wei



On 27 January 2020, we lost Professor Stephen HY Wei. It is difficult to summarise in a few lines his academic and scientific achievements, and recall all the initiatives he supported towards the Hong Kong dental health industry.

Former Chair Professor and Head of the Department of Children's Dentistry and Orthodontics, and Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry, as well as the former Director of the Prince Philip Dental Hospital, Professor Wei has been a beacon for the entire dental community, with special regards to the development of Paediatric Dentistry.

Professor Wei was on the Inaugural Organizing Committee of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine and served as the Inaugural President of the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong. He was also the first Chairman of the Board of Examiners of the Hong Kong Dental Council Statutory Examination for Licensure of overseas dentists in Hong Kong and served as the Editor-in- Chief of the Hong Kong Dental Journal.

He has lectured extensively all over the world and has published over 60 chapters in books and monographs, as well as more than 200 research and clinical papers. In 2013, a scholarship was set up under his name to encourage and support undergraduate dental students to take part in dental community with a focus on paediatric health projects.

As the Founding President of the Hong Kong Society of Paediatric Dentistry, Professor Wei served many terms in that role to which growth he contributed so largely. He was a highly regarded professor and mentor to many of us and his loss will be felt by the entire local dental community.
