PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Fellows and Members,

This is the second year of my Presidency in the College and I wish you all a happy Chinese New Year of 2021 - the Year of the Ox.



The year 2020 was an unprecedented challenge for human being. The Covid-19 has been roaring around the world for over a year and has now infected over 100 million people worldwide resulting in over two million deaths. In Hong Kong, the pandemic is still rampant with no signs of achieving the goal of “zero infection”. We all ponder when we can return to our normal life.

As various countries have launched their biggest ever vaccination programmes and we start to see light at the end of the tunnel. However, there are still many uncertainties that have not been answered yet. There are still insufficient research data on different brands of vaccine – their efficacies on different age groups; their possible side effects; their limitations and long-term effects. Other public health measures such as tracking possible infected cases, social distancing rules, travel bans and restrictions to prevent cross-border cases, lockdowns in some districts, mandatory confinement, etc. are still important. Yet another challenge is to save the economy while the effects of such measures have taken a toll on the already poor economy after the 2019 social unrest.

While Hong Kong has been facing insurmountable crises, the College also faced many challenges. The Legal Case ended with the High Court handed down a summary judgment on cost of one million instead of 3.5 million to the Plaintiff while our submission to reversal of decision was declined by the Court on 27 October 2020. The Council decided not to appeal because we anticipated further protracted engagement might cause the College considerable financial difficulties. The College would like to dedicate our resources on education and training of our members instead of engaging in further legal disputes.

Through the concerted efforts and unfailing supports from specialty boards, Council members and our dedicated Secretariat, the College managed to conduct our own intermediate examinations in the Specialties of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Paedodontics, Endodontics, Prosthodontics and Periodontology in 2020. Exit examinations of the above specialties and Orthodontics were also conducted successfully, together with uneventful completion of the MGD training and examination diet. Two Scientific meetings were held as scheduled via Zoom and were well-received with high attendance. Online CME activities were recognized and accredited. Therefore, the specialist training mission of the College was sustained and continually materialized amidst the pandemic. We have consolidated our fundamental strengths and overcome many difficulties. I would like to express my heartfelt thanks and pay tributes to all those who have contributed.

I am grateful to the Councilors who entrusted me to remain in the Presidency of the College for another year. To this, I pledge to serve with a humble and sober spirit. We also welcome two new Councilors – Dr. Gary Cheuk Hang SO and Dr. Tsz Leung WONG; while our two Past Presidents, Dr. Robert Pong Yin NG and Dr. Edmond Ho Nang POW, left the Council after serving the College for twelve years. On behalf of the Council, I would like to thank them for their unfaltering contributions to the College.

Upon considering the pros and cons of conducting the Conferment Ceremony, the Council initially planned to postpone it to late January 2021, but finally came to a decision to cancel it because of the persistent pandemic and gathering restrictions. We plan to let all the new fellows and members to attend the coming ceremony to be held in November 2021. Hopefully the pandemic will be controlled and the gathering restrictions will be eased at that time.

The College will get some new development in this year. As over one third of our Fellows have been admitted for less than ten years, the College decides to establish a Young Fellow Chapter, which will be inaugurated in the first half of 2021, to enhance the communication and involvement of young fellows with the College. The Young Fellow Chapter Council will compose of one representative from each Specialty and Dr. Yolanda Yee Hung LAW has been appointed as the first Chairperson of the Young Fellow Chapter Council. I would like to take this opportunity to invite more young fellows to participate in College activities and bring new momentum to the College.

The year 2021 will still be full of challenges and uncertainties. Let us join together and overcome difficulties ahead. Let us stay staunch with vigilance and determination. Until then, please keep safe and have a healthy and prosperous 2021.

Patients are not always aware of the facts of their treatment after consent related discussions and they are influenced by the way in which information is presented. Yet the difficulties of conveying information about treatment and risks should not be taken to indicate that patients are incapable of understanding medical information or that patient's autonomy in decision making is meaningless. Rather it shows that the communication process has strong influence on how patients understand, remember and evaluate information - all of which are essential to informed consent.

DENTAL YOUNG FELLOWS CHAPTER

It is our pleasure to announce the setting up of the Dental Young Fellows Chapter (“Chapter”), a subcommittee under the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (CDSHK) in 2021. All fellows who have become Fellows of the CDSHK for not more than 10 years will become members of the Dental Young Fellows Chapter and be considered as “Young Fellows”. The Chapter can act as a platform of communication between the Young Fellows and the College Council on training and other issues relevant to the Young Fellows. Through engagement in CDSHK activities, interflow, collaboration and networking among Young Fellows can be enhanced and their sense of belongings to the CDSHK will be deepened.

Back in 2017, The Academy of Medicine established the Young Fellows Chapter with representatives from 15 Academy Colleges for those having obtained Academy Fellowships within the past 10 years. The aim is to nurture future healthcare leaders by involving Young Fellows in various activities and affairs of the Academy for them to better understand the objectives and work of the Academy. The Young Fellows are dedicated to joining various committees and the co-ordination of activities to connect Fellows of different specialties, building ties and strengthening bonds.



The Young Fellows Chapter has been invited to co-ordinate panel discussions during the flagship and annual conferences of the Academy, such as the Medical Education Conference and 25th Anniversary Congress. Topics covered include “Curriculum Reform from Young Fellows / Trainees Perspectives” and “Looking After the Mental Health of Our Own Profession”.



Study tours for Young Fellows to understand healthcare systems and developments, as well as foster exchanges of medical knowledge and experience was organized in February 2019 - the first 5-day study tour to Sichuan participated by a group of 25 young Fellows and specialist trainees.

Social and sports activities are also part of the different connecting activities, which are organised by Social Subcommittee for enhancement of Fellows' mental, physical and social well-being.



With the success from the Young Fellows Chapter of the Academy of Medicine and support from the College Council and Specialty Boards of the CDSHK, the first Dental Young Fellows Chapter was formed by representatives from each specialty.

Each term of the Dental Young Fellows Chapter will start from April each year to the end of March next year. The first committee meeting was held in January 2021 to start the preparation with the guidance from previous Young Fellows Chapter representatives Dr. Tom Fu Tak HO and Dr. Julianna Cho Hwei LIEW. Depending on the pandemic situation, various activities for the Young Fellows, including Young Fellows Seminar in early 2022 and social activities such as sports competition are planned. Introductory seminar of the specialist training pathway for the dental students and general dental practitioners will be held in the summer of 2021. Young Fellows are also encouraged to engage in other activities organized by the Academy of Medicine and Young Fellows Chapter to strengthen the collaborations with other Medical specialties.

NEW ACCREDITED TRAINING CENTRES

INSTITUTE FOR ADVANCED DENTISTRY – MULTI-SPECIALITY CLINIC



Institute for Advanced Dentistry - Multi-Specialty Clinic (IAD-MSC) of the Faculty of Dentistry, The University of Hong Kong is a newly accredited training centre by the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong. This newly established training centre is situated at 2/F, Novum West, 460 Queen's Road West, Sai Wan; which is conveniently located in close proximity to the MTR Exit B1 of the HKU Station. IAD-MSC is a state-of-the-art dental facility covering the floor area of approximately 15,000 sq. ft. equipped with 45 dental chairs. This new establishment provides an excellent environment for important learning and clinical practicing opportunities for postgraduate students of the Faculty of Dentistry, the University of Hong Kong. IAD-MSC is also devoted to providing clinical specialist training to both our Basic and Higher Trainees of the Specialist Training Pathways in the following Specialty Fields:

- Community Dentistry
- Endodontics
- Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
- Orthodontics
- Paediatric Dentistry
- Periodontology
- Prosthodontics

The IAD-MSC is a referral-based training centre that accepts referral of cases from both public and private dental practitioners in Hong Kong for patients that require advanced level of dental care. As a non-governmental dental clinic in Hong Kong, IAD-MSC offers dental services at affordable fees. The operation of the centre is facilitated by efficient centralized booking, easy digital inter-specialty referrals and several dental specialties in one location; all of which contribute to the proper training of our Trainees in inter-disciplinary collaboration and management of cases.

COVID-19 UPDATE


Prevention of Pneumonia and Respiratory Tract Infection




- Perform hand hygiene frequently
- Wash hands with liquid soap and water, and rub for at least 20 seconds
- When hands are not visibly soiled, hand hygiene with 70 to 80% alcohol-based handrub is effective





- After using toilet, put the lid down before flushing
- Wash hands thoroughly
- Spit into tissue and dispose of it properly




- Maintain drainage pipes properly and add water to the U-traps regularly
- Pour half a litre of water into each drain outlet every week




- Cover your mouth and nose with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing, dispose of soiled tissues into a lidded rubbish bin, then wash hands thoroughly
- If tissue is not available, may cough into clothes or upper sleeves



- When having a fever or respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask and seek medical advice promptly



- The coloured side/side with folds facing downwards should face outwards with the metallic strip uppermost
- Position the elastic bands around both ears
- Extend the surgical mask to fully cover mouth, nose and chin
- Mould the metallic strip over nose bridge, to fit snugly over the face

- 經常保持雙手清潔
- 洗手時應以視液和清水清潔雙手，搓手最少20秒
- 當雙手沒有明顯污垢時，可用含70至80%酒精搓手液潔手





- 如廁後先蓋廁板再沖廁
- 徹底清潔雙手
- 吐痰應用紙巾包好再丟




- 妥善保養排水渠管定期注水入U型隔氣
- 每星期把半公升水倒入所有排水口




- 打噴嚏或咳嗽時應用紙巾掩蓋口鼻，正確棄置已染污的紙巾，然後徹底清潔雙手
- 如沒有紙巾，可用上衣或袖掩蓋



- 當出現發燒或呼吸道感染病徵，應戴上外科口罩及盡早向醫生求診



- 有顏色/摺紋向下的面向外，有金屬條的一邊向上
- 橡筋繞在耳朵上
- 拉開口罩，完全覆蓋口、鼻和下巴
- 把金屬條沿鼻樑兩側按緊，緊貼面部
