


Thank you for all your support and for giving me a chance to be a Councillor. I will do my best in this post and bring more new impetus to the College, the Academy, the dental profession and the community.

Run/Walk Challenge:

Event Summary

On 19th March 2023, the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (CDSHK) and the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM) commemorated their 30th Anniversary with a Run/Walk Challenge at the West Kowloon Cultural District. 







































Latte Art Workshop:

WINTER SCIENTIFIC MEETING 2022

DENTISTRY AND MEDICINE – INTER- AND INTRA-DISCIPLINARY NETWORKING PART 3: ONCOLOGY AND RECONSTRUCTION

6 NOVEMBER 2022

This was the finale and Part 3 of the 'Dentistry and Medicine – Inter and intra-Disciplinary Networking' series with the theme of Oncology and Reconstruction. We had 308 online and 66 physical attendees at the Pao Yuk Kong Auditorium.

Our President, Dr. Katherine Leung kicked off the event and welcomed our audience. The morning session was chaired by Dr. Gary So and Dr. Amelia Cheung. We were privileged to have the following speakers: Dr. Fung Siu Chung, Michael Chao and Crystal Ng from the Department of Dentistry and OMFS, the United Christian Hospital, highlighting the dental role in managing oral cancer. Dr. Polly Fung, a private practitioner, introduced the oral medicine approach in managing oral potentially malignant disorders. Next, we had Dr. Jeren Lim from the division of Head and Neck Surgery of the Department of Surgery, the United Christian Hospital, discuss the surgical aspect of oral cancer. The morning session was completed by Dr. Kwan Chung Kong, Department of Oncology, the United Christian Hospital, who gave us an update on the non-surgical treatment of oral cancer.













The afternoon session was chaired by Dr. Jason Wong and Dr. Jerome Yu. Dr. Au Ka Li and Dr. Yau Kar Yin from the Department of Dentistry and OMFS, the United Christian Hospital, presented the OMS aspect, complication management and the role for pre-prosthetic and craniofacial prosthesis. Dr. Patrick Wu, a specialist in Prosthodontics, introduced to us the dental and maxillofacial prosthetic reconstruction in resected tumour defects. Prof. Richard Su from OMFS, Faculty of Dentistry, HKU, concluded the program by sharing with us the experiences of his team in using new technologies for oral cancer diagnosis and treatment.

PROFESSOR CHEUNG LIM KWONG'S OBITUARY

Professor Cheung Lim Kwong

BDS, PhD, FFD RCS (Irel), FDS RCPS (Glasg), FRACDS, FRACDS (OMS), FHKAM (Dental Surgery), FCDSHK (OMS), FDS RCSEd, FFGDP (UK)

18 September 1958 – 19 November 2022

We feel sorrow at the passing of Lim. Dying at 64 years of age is too young by today's standard.

Despite that, he had lived a colourful life with numerous achievements. When he had graduated from his dental school in Glasgow, he decided to return to HK and became a lecturer in Oral Surgery in the Dental Faculty, The University of Hong Kong. I remember I was one of his students and amongst many others, we were very impressed by his refreshing style of teaching. His lecture was full of energy so easy to engage the audience.

Hong Kong had changed in many ways in the last four decades leading to plenty of opportunities and challenges to every one of us including Lim. He was able to seize with the tide of evolution during the wave of China-Hong Kong Integration. He became the professor in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at one stage, and established his private practice at a later stage.



At the peak of his teaching career, as a well-rounded clinical surgeon who was always at the forefront of the specialty, he had much to give students and trainees. As an established clinical surgeon, he was courageous and gifted.

He never slowed down in his life journey, and he always managed with ease in spite of wearing so many hats. His death was such a loss to his family, friends, colleagues, and patients. As a respected colleague, beloved friend, renowned academician, and talented surgeon, he will continue to live in our memories.
