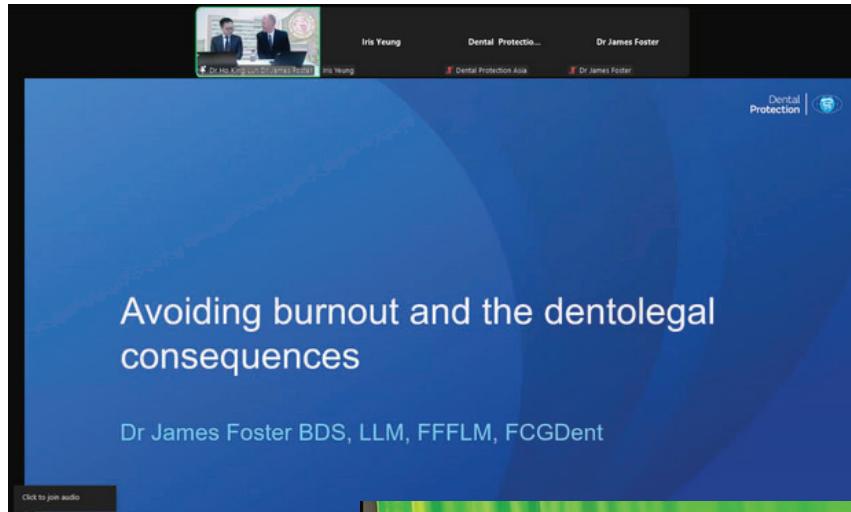

Webinar on Recognizing and Managing Burnout in Dentistry: A Resounding Success

On October 17, 2024, Dental Protection, the Medical Protection Society, and the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (CDSHK) jointly hosted a highly insightful webinar aimed at addressing the critical issue of burnout among dental professionals. With 184 dedicated participants in attendance, the event provided valuable knowledge on recognizing and managing the symptoms of burnout, ensuring better personal well-being and patient care. This was particularly beneficial for our fellows and members.





The session, held online via Zoom, featured an expert speaker, Dr. James Foster, Deputy Dental Director and the Dental Australia/Asia Lead at Dental Protection, and was moderated by Dr. Ho King Lun, Chairman of the Scientific Meetings Committee at CDSHK. Dr. Foster's expertise and engaging presentation was highly appreciated by all attendees.

Participants earned 1 point each for CDSHK CME/CPD (Category C) and DCHK CPD (Core H). This event was a testament to the continuous commitment to professional development and well-being of dental practitioners.

After the Milk Tea and Egg Tart Workshop, the DYFC committee (2024-2025) had organized two more activities. They were “Workshop on Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Cap. 633) – points to note including legal requirements on small practice clinics” on 29 October 2024 and “Workshop on Effective Communication Skills for Complaint Management” on 23 February 2025.

Workshop on Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Cap. 633) – points to note including legal requirements on small practice clinics (29 October 2024)

The Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (PHFO) was gazetted on November 2018 and the Government is implementing the PHFO in phases. The Code of Practice for Hospitals and Day Procedure Centres is already in effect, and the one for Clinics is expected to launch in the year 2025. We were so grateful to have Dr. Andrew But and Dr. Kathy Chan, the Senior Dental Officers of Dental Regulatory and Law Enforcement, Department of Health to introduce the requirements for Day Procedure Centre (DPC) and small practice clinics under Cap.633 to our fellows and trainees as our second activity of DYFC. The workshop highlighted some important points in complying with requirements under Cap. 633, covering governance, staffing, facilities and equipment, service delivery, quality and safety of care, infection control, and other operational matters. Dr. But and Dr. Chan provided lots of useful tips with examples illustrating the application of Cap. 633. The attendees enjoyed the workshop and actively participated in small group discussions by raising questions relevant to their current practice. The interactive section was useful particularly to those young fellows who plan to start a new practice in the future.

Workshop on Effective Communication Skills for Complaint Management (23 February 2025)

For the third DYFC activity, we have invited Ms. Scarlett Tsoi, an expert in mediation and counselling, to enhance our skills in handling complaints with real case scenario illustrations. Her lively presentation aroused the attendees' interest. She also introduced the VAK (visual, auditory and kinaesthetic) learning model to analyze our own strengths and weaknesses, which was very useful when tackling conflicts. The participants were invited to have a role play to simulate real life situation when handling complaints. All the participants enjoyed so much especially when their role was “patients” to make a complaint face to face to their “dentist”. Besides learning the skills in handling complaints, maybe stress relieving workshop is necessary and could be included in the list of our future activities.

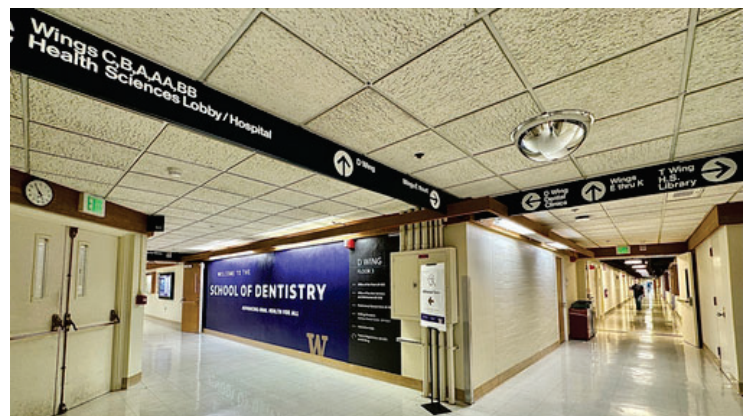

Literature Review (Mondays, 9am - 12pm)

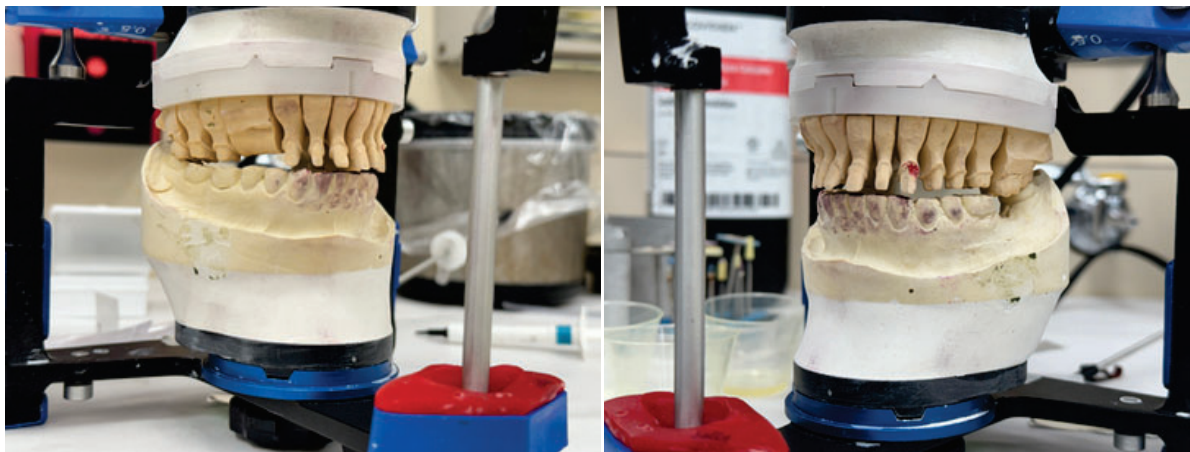
Professor Ramos, the Director of Grad Pros, led literature review sessions where residents presented journal articles and formulated questions relevant to board examinations. Prof. Ramos engaged the residents by asking probing questions and providing constructive criticism to stimulate their critical thinking. During my observership, topics discussed included implant complications, implant shade selection, occlusion, digitalized complete dentures, implant surface treatments, and the fracture resistance of zirconia crowns with different preparations for occlusal rest seats.

Prosthodontic Clinical Sessions (Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, 1pm - 5pm)

I observed clinical sessions of residents, supervised by Professors Ramos, Sorensen, and Sutton. The cases included consultation for new cases, complete denture procedures, immediate denture procedures, implant retained overdenture on bar, full-mouth rehabilitation on natural teeth, and full-arch implant-supported fixed partial dentures. The supervisors and residents were incredibly generous in sharing their knowledge and clinical skills.

Complete Denture Lectures (Tuesdays, 9am - 12pm)

Prof. Ramos delivered comprehensive lectures on complete dentures, covering topics such as final impression techniques, record bases and wax rims, maxillo-mandibular records, anterior tooth selection, denture occlusion, flasking and de-flasking, and denture delivery.

Multidisciplinary Case Presentation (Wednesdays, 7:30am - 9:00am)

Residents presented multidisciplinary cases involving the Orthodontic, Periodontic, and Prosthodontic departments and were commented on by supervisors and residents from different departments.

Maxillofacial Lectures (Thursdays, 9:45am - 12pm, except August 15, 2024)

Professor Sutton, who is the director of Maxillofacial Prosthetics Services, delivered lectures on topics such as speech-aid prostheses (nasopharyngeal obturation), mandibular resection and reconstruction, and the role of hyperbaric oxygen in maxillofacial rehabilitation. His engaging lecturing style, which included mimicking compromised speech, made the sessions both informative and enjoyable.



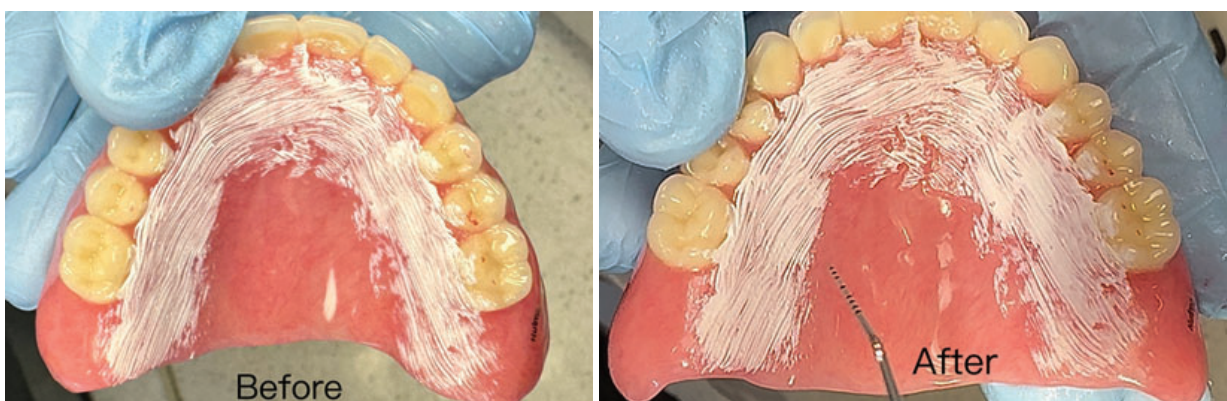

Occlusion Literature Review (August 15, 2024 9am-12pm)

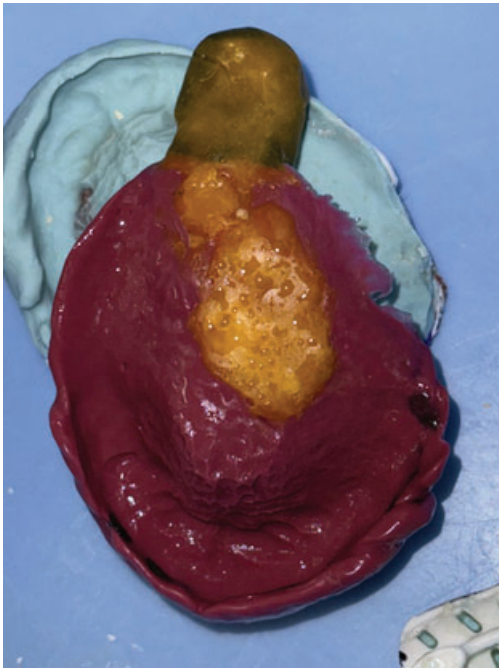
I attended the final session of this seven-class course, where first-year residents from the Grad Pros and Perio summarized and discussed articles on the topic "Possible Role of Occlusal Traumatism in Periodontal Disease" with Prof. Ramos.

Maxillofacial Prosthetic Clinic (Wednesdays 9am-5pm and Thursdays 1pm - 5pm)

I observed Prof. Sutton providing dental treatments to patients before and after maxillofacial surgeries, including pre-surgical consultations, immediate and early reviews after surgeries, obturator review and relining, nasal prosthesis wax-up and shade matching, and the conversion of removable complete dentures to provisional fixed implant-supported FPDs.

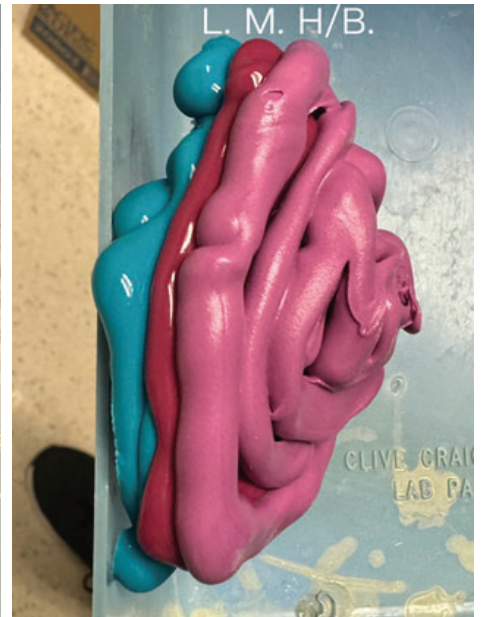
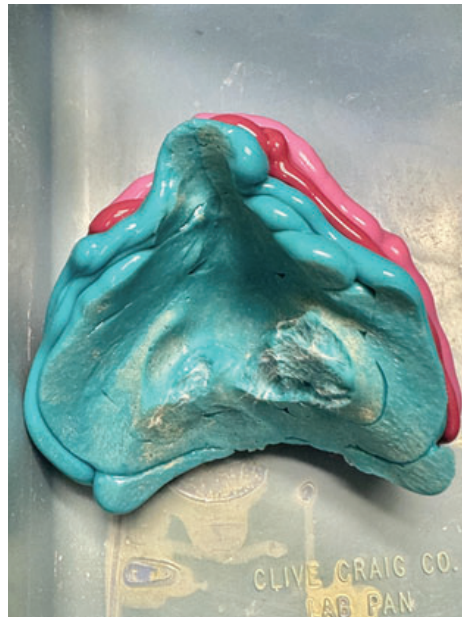


Palatogram for Speech Evaluation After Glossectomy

Removable Partial Denture Lectures (July 26 and August 16, 8:30am - 12pm)

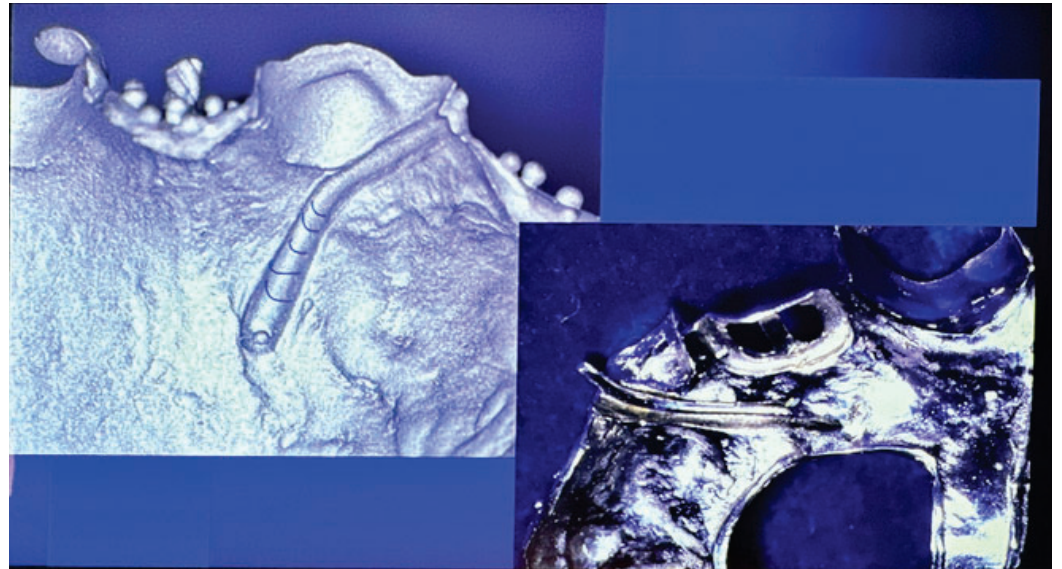
Professor. Zhang, whose research interest in biomimetic restorative materials, dental implantology and applications of innovative technology in Prosthodontics and Restorative dentistry, delivered lectures on Brudvik's removable partial denture design, which includes the use of metal veneers for rest seats, attachments such as Extracoronal Resilient Attachments, bars, twin flex clasps to avoid visible clasps, and multiple crowns with lingual ledges for support.

Prof. Sutton discussed different categories of rotational path of insertion and advanced designs such as the Equipoise Esthetic Clasp and the Swing Lock design.



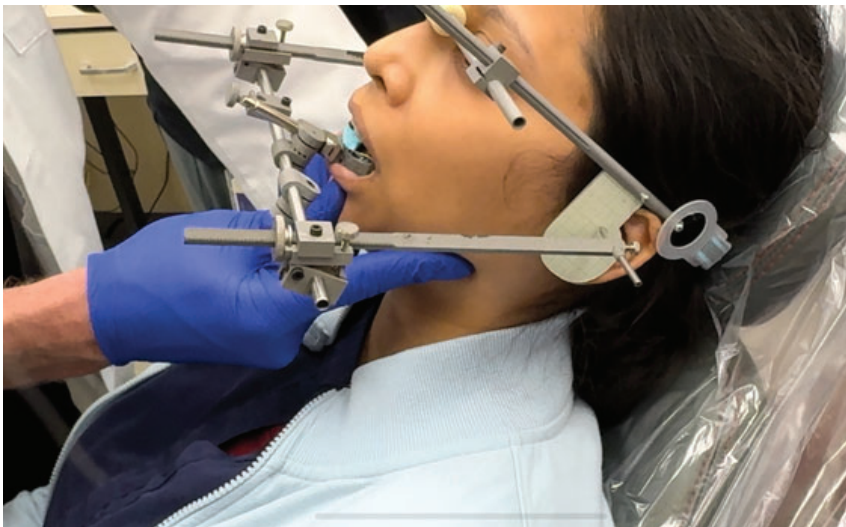

**In Loving Memory of Mr. Eric. PEAKE,
Hon FCDSHK (1997)**

Mr. Eric Peake, a distinguished administrator and esteemed public servant in Hong Kong and elsewhere, passed away peacefully on November 17, 2024 in the United Kingdom., aged 91.

Eric Peake brought to the position of Comptroller of the Prince Philip Dental Hospital a wide array of administrative skills honed during his many years as a civil servant with the Hong Kong Government, serving, as was then the custom, in many departments and units. He had further developed great experience in interacting with various Government Departments through his involvement in the development of the Kowloon Park Mosque and Islamic Centre.

Mr. Peake proved himself to be a highly effective Comptroller. He was popular with the hospital's staff and was gentlemanly in his dealings with all, including the Faculty of Dentistry academics. He was most approachable and gave all issues raised careful but prompt consideration.

In 1986, the Working Party on Postgraduate Medical Examination and Training, under the chairmanship of Oncologist Dr. Keith Halnan or what is called 'the Halnan Report' recommended that Hong Kong take charge of postgraduate training, accreditation, and recognition of the status of medical specialists in Hong Kong. This resulted in preparatory work for the formation of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM) and the establishment of the Colleges that would become designated constituent colleges of the future Academy. From the outset, the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (CDSHK) was one such college. Eric Peake acted, in an entirely voluntary and honorary capacity, as Secretary to committees in the process of establishing the CDSHK, and he advised extensively on the processes required to comply with the Academy Ordinance, which was enacted in 1992, with the inaugural ceremony of the HKAM being held in December 1993. Eric Peake further worked with the CDSHK in enabling and facilitating the higher training of dentists within the Prince Philip Dental Hospital, a development of which he was an eager supporter. He also made valuable suggestions as to the way in which the CDSHK could be administered going forward.

In recognition of Mr. Eric Peake's singular contributions to the establishment of the CDSHK, the College Council bestowed upon Eric an Honorary Fellowship. On the day of his conferral, his sons recall: "Dad telling us it was the proudest day of his entire working career." In his dedicated but humorous and self-effacing style, Eric Peake had indeed served the CDSHK with distinction.

The CDSHK pays tribute to Mr. Peake, honoring his remarkable dentistry contributions and enduring impact on dental training in Hong Kong. We extend our deepest condolences to his family and loved ones during this difficult time.

May Mr. Eric Peake's memory be a blessing and his legacy of excellence in administration be cherished forever.
