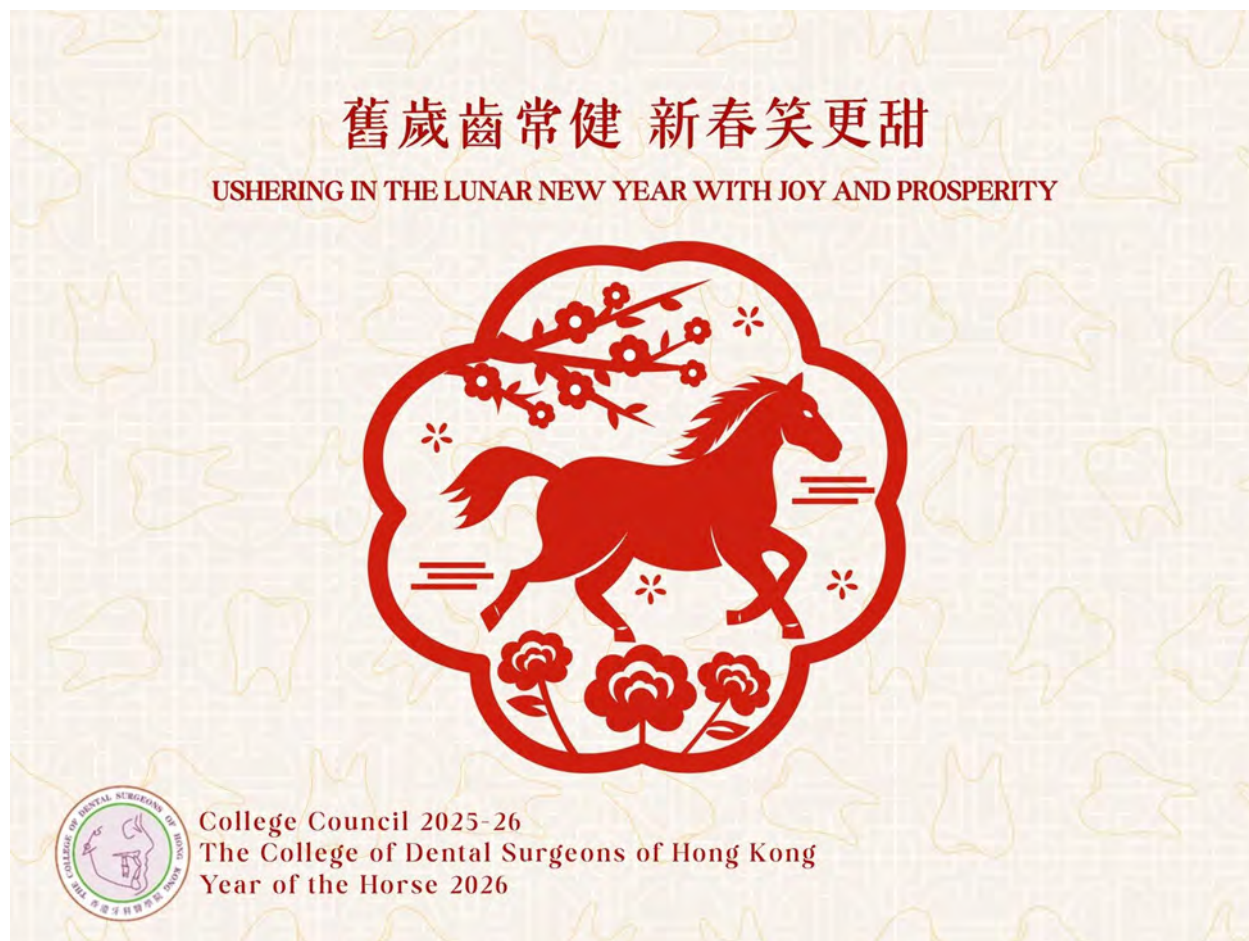

# **Dental Trails: A Wellness Hike on 25 January 2026**

## **By Dental Young Fellows Chapter, CDSHK**

Dentistry is a demanding profession that often results in high stress levels and burnout. Occupational hazards such as poor posture, lack of physical activity, and limited networking opportunities can further strain the physical and mental well-being of dental professionals. The hiking gathering, led by an experienced mountain craft assistant coach and life coach, engaged participants through mindfulness practices, coping strategies, and tips for maintaining physical health. In addition to allowing participants to enjoy the sceneries of the Sir Cecil's Ride and Victoria Harbour, this activity raised awareness of mental health and self-wellness, helping to enhance resilience and address mental health concerns. Additionally, this stress-relieving activity offered valuable opportunities for members to establish and strengthen the sense of support within the group, enabling them to better cope with the demands and daily stresses of their professional lives.

This event is supported by Hong Kong Jockey Club / Government Funding to support promulgation and capacity in medical professionalism and ongoing initiatives for promotion of doctors' well-being.

The activity was delivered by Ms LI Sohan, a certified mountain craft assistant coach with different related certifications in life coaching. Participants gained knowledge about mental well-being and coping strategies for daily stress.

Event objectives:

1. An interactive hiking event on mindfulness practices, coping strategies, and tips for maintaining physical health will be conducted for the participants. Participants will gain knowledge about mental well-being and coping strategies for daily stress.
2. Participants will develop self-awareness of their mental state and overall well-being through the information shared during the hiking event.
3. Participants will have the opportunity to practice mindfulness techniques. They will be equipped with practical skills through engaging in hands-on exercises, allowing them to apply mindfulness methods effectively in their daily lives.
4. Participants will have the opportunity to network with fellows, members, and trainees from other colleges. This will help strengthen their support networks, enhancing their ability to cope with stress and daily challenges.
5. Participants will undertake a hiking journey accompanied by a certified mountain craft assistant coach, who will provide clear route guidance, instructions, and safety measures.

We truly became more energetic with much less stress load to prepare for more challenging second part of hiking.

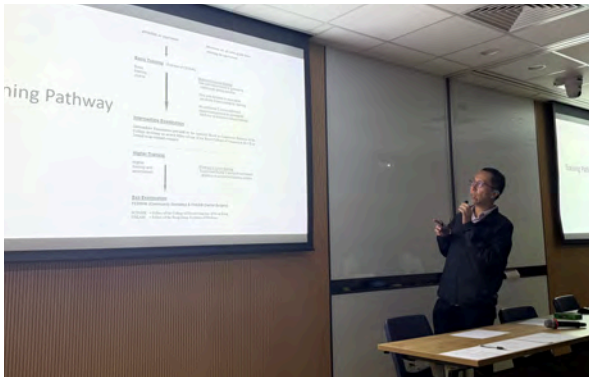

# Observership Experience at Taoyuan Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Craniofacial Centre

My two-month observership at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital's Craniofacial Centre in Taoyuan was a transformative experience that deepened my understanding of advanced maxillofacial surgical techniques. Working in the Department of Dentistry and Maxillofacial Surgery at a public hospital in Hong Kong, I was already familiar with some of the department's protocols that our team has referenced. Attending the Chang Gung Forum twice during my MDS and early training years had introduced me to their work, but I realized that these forums only provided brief insights. Thanks to the CDSHK overseas scholarship and my department's support, I had the opportunity to fully immerse myself in their protocols and surgical techniques.

The Chang Gung Craniofacial Centre is renowned for its pioneering "surgery-first" orthognathic surgery approach, developed in collaboration with in-house orthodontists. Over the past 30 years, they have refined techniques under the leadership of their founder, Dr NOORDHOFF, a plastic surgeon who introduced cleft surgeries, orthognathic surgeries, and plastic revision techniques to Taiwan. The centre's expertise extends to managing syndromic cases, microtia surgeries, and obstructive sleep apnea, earning international recognition. Beyond surgery, the centre is academically active, hosting annual forums, webinars, and training programs, while fostering collaborations with international institutes and welcoming visiting fellows.

During my observership, I participated in surgeries, outpatient clinics, ward rounds, and academic sessions. I observed over 30 orthognathic surgeries, 10 alveolar grafting procedures, and various craniofacial and plastic surgeries. I was impressed by their meticulous attention to detail, such as the use of light retractors in BSSRO and Le Fort procedures, innovative bone grafting techniques, and layered suturing to minimize hematomas and scarring. Their workflow for surgery-first orthognathic surgeries, which sets immediate post-operative occlusion into orthodontist-approved alignment, demonstrated their commitment to reducing treatment time and enhancing patient outcomes.

I also observed Dr Arthur LIN at Linkou Chang Gung Hospital, specializing in TMJ arthroscopy and discopexy. This minimally invasive technique, which repositions the TMJ disc with small puncture holes, offers significant cosmetic and functional advantages over open surgery and showcases Dr LIN's dedication to advancing this challenging procedure. Additionally, I visited private clinics in Taipei, where former Chang Gung staff performed orthognathic surgeries using the "Chang Gung technique." These visits highlighted the differences between hospital and private practice settings and expanded my perspective on maxillofacial procedures.

Overall, my attachment to Chang Gung Hospital was an invaluable learning experience. It broadened my technical knowledge, enhanced my appreciation for interdisciplinary collaboration, and strengthened my connection with their team. I look forward to continuing this collaboration in the future.

## **The College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong Scholarship 2026**

The College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong Scholarship was set up in 2011 to support Fellows and Higher Trainees to have opportunity in gaining overseas training experience in their specialties. Preference will be given to young colleagues who are admitted as our College Fellows within 5 years.

The maximum amount of the Scholarship is HK\$50,000 for the Year 2026. Application for the Scholarship is now open to all of our College Fellows and Higher Trainees. The training programme, which will be self-arranged for a duration not more than 8 weeks, requires prior approval by the College Council. The scholarship cannot be held in conjunction with any other award, grant or sponsorship that will give financial support for the same training event.

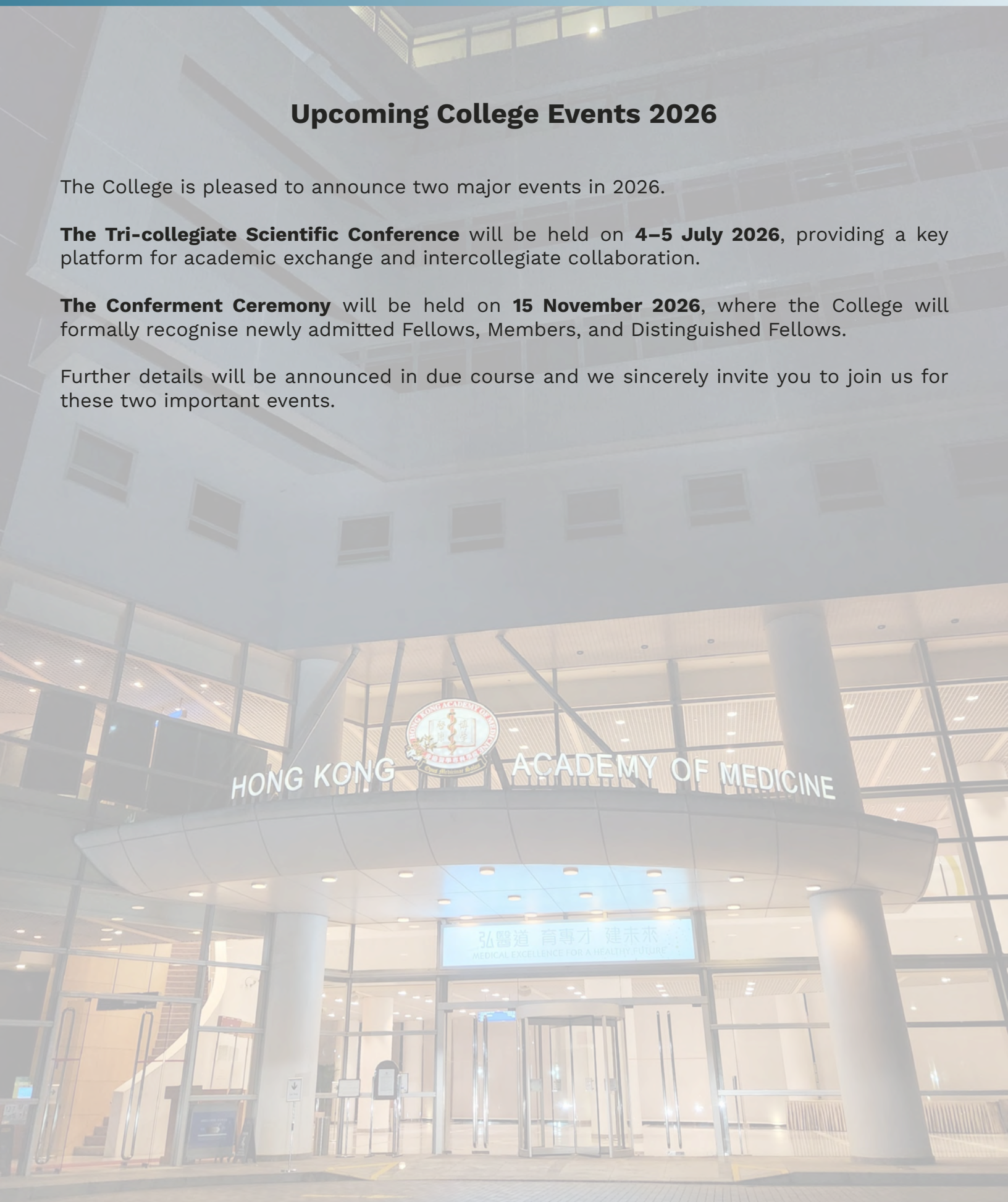
## Upcoming College Events 2026
